DEPARTMENT SUMMARY AND REQUESTED BOARD ACTION:

During this election season, it has come to my attention that many candidates are in violation of law and ordinance in the placement of their campaign signs. Section 1480 et seq. of the California Streets and Highways Code discusses obstructions to County highways and provides powers to the Road Commissioner for their removal.

The Department of Transportation recommends that the Board of Supervisors direct that (1) all candidates place their signs in conformance with law, (2) provide a seven-day period to ensure compliance, and (3) direct the Department of Transportation to remove offending signs remaining after the grace period and recover the cost of removal from the affected candidates.
