October 20, 2008

El Dorado County Board of Supervisors and Roger Trout

I understand that you will be meeting on October 21, 2008 to consider laying off numerous positions in the community development department. I work closely with the building division and would like you to consider my input. Inspection activity is currently about 25% or less from 2005. I've been involved in El Dorado County since 1979 and have experienced the slow process that it takes the County to add positions and then the painful process of cutting jobs. The building department no doubt needs to cut some jobs and probably should have cut some positions more than a year ago. But from what I'm hearing , your considering cutting deep into the experienced people you have working there. I would ask that you work with Larry Loman and try to keep some of the more valuable people so that when building activity picks up you don't have to scramble to hire people and avoid the result in delays. The essential work at the building department is plan check and field inspections and I urge you to cut back in all other areas and use job sharing or early retirement to keep your



most experienced people.
