Hi Gail,

This email is to document some of the telephone conversations we have had and to be clear as to what is being approved, waived or denied.

The Probation Department would like to pay to have this vendor provide (at our Shingle Springs location) four (4), four (4) hour seminars over two consecutive days at the cost of \$5,000.00. We've been advised by Procurement & Contract's to create a requisition (RQ) for a direct Purchase Order (PO).

Previously on 08/04/15, you had agreed to the following;

- Risk Management approves WC Waiver
- Risk Management approves evidence of auto liability insurance complying with State law
- Risk Management waives GL "if" classes are taught on our premises
- Risk Management requires vendor MUST have Professional E&O insurance to teach at the County.

Our department will be taking an item before the Board of Supervisors to request the waiver of the E&O insurance requirement and to authorize the Department Head to sign the PO.
