



## RESOLUTION NO. 058-2025

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

**AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO CLAIM AN ALLOCATION OF \$84,223 IN TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT LOCAL TRANSPORTATION FUNDS FOR THE INTERSECTION SAFETY/ PEDESTRIAN SAFETY IMPROVEMENT - ORIENTAL, CHURCH, RACQUET, & PLEASANT VALLEY PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Resolution 23/24.03, the El Dorado County Transportation Commission (EDCTC) allocated \$84,223 of Transportation Development Act Local Transportation Funds (TDA LTF) for the Intersection Safety/ Pedestrian Safety Improvement - Oriental, Church, Racquet, & Pleasant Valley Project, Capital Improvement Program (CIP) number 36105061, to the El Dorado County Department of Transportation (Transportation); and

**WHEREAS**, during the design phase of the Intersection Safety/ Pedestrian Safety Improvement - Oriental, Church, Racquet, & Pleasant Valley Project, Transportation pursued construction funding; and

**WHEREAS**, Transportation intends to use TDA LTF funding to construct the Intersection Safety/ Pedestrian Safety Improvement - Oriental, Church, Racquet, & Pleasant Valley Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the El Dorado County Department of Transportation is authorized to accept the TDA LTF funding to be used for the Intersection Safety/ Pedestrian Safety Improvement - Oriental, Church, Racquet, & Pleasant Valley Project, CIP number 36105061, and delegates to the Director of Transportation the authority to execute and file claims for the receipt of the TDA LTF funds, consistent with the process established by the Transportation Development Act Guidelines adopted by EDCTC.
