## REQUEST REFERENCE:

This study is for Casa Largo Way, from Gailey Circle (No. 643) to Merrychase Drive (No. 334), a length of 0.03 of a mile. It is the scope of this study to determine if parking restrictions are warranted and in the best interest of public safety on Casa Largo Way. This study was undertaken by the Division of Transportation of El Dorado County in response to a petition and written request by Betty Humphreys on behalf of the adjoining Oak Crest Subdivision, requesting "no parking anytime" restrictions on the south side of Casa Largo Way. The parking issues on Casa Largo Way are associated with parents picking up or dropping off students at the adjoining Blue Oak Elementary School.

## GENERAL PHYSICAL CONDITIONS:

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Casa Largo Way is in good condition and is classified as a local road by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), as depicted by the California Road System (CRS) maps. Casa Largo Way is a two (2) lane undivided road with an overall width of 26 feet with four (4) foot wide sidewalks on both sides of the roadway. Casa Largo Way is controlled by "STOP" Sign, Stop bar, legend, lane line, and school crosswalk at the Merrychase Drive intersection. No stop sign or associated striping exists at the Gailey Circle intersection.

The alignment of Casa Largo Way is level with no horizontal curves along its length. No pavement markings are present along the remaining portion of Casa Largo Way. Although residential homes do exist along this portion of Casa Largo Way, no residential homes fronts and access Casa Largo Way.

## RECORD DATA:

Although no traffic count data was available on Casa Largo Way, the average daily traffic (ADT) volume counts on Casa Largo Way can be estimated to be 500 vehicles per day. Merrychase Drive yielded an average daily traffic (ADT) count of 1,592 ADT in the year 2012 (see attached).

A review of the accident data provided by the California Highway Patrol for a three (3) year period from January 1, 2011, through December 31, 2013, disclosed that no accidents were reported along the entire portion of Casa Largo Way (see attached).

The California Vehicle Code, Section 22507, states in part:
"Local Regulations: Local authorities may, by ordinance or resolution, prohibit or restrict the stopping, parking, or standing of vehicles, including, but not limited to, vehicles that are six feet or more in height (including any load thereon) within 100 feet of any intersection, on certain streets or highways, or portions thereof, during all or certain hours of the day."

Section 21458 (a) of The California Vehicle Code states:
"Curb Markings: Whenever local authorities enact local parking regulations and indicate them by the use of paint upon curbs, the following colors only shall be used, and the colors indicate as follows: (1) Red indicates no stopping, standing, or parking, whether the vehicle is attended or unattended, except that a bus may stop in a red zone marked or signposted as a bus loading zone."

El Dorado County Resolution No. 252-81 (attached) establishes "No Parking" zones pursuant to Section 10.12.010 of the El Dorado County Ordinance Code.

El Dorado County Ordinance Code Section 10.12.010 states:
"When properly posted, it is unlawful for any person to park or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or unattended, within any portion of the right-of-way of any county road or bridge as established by resolution of the board of supervisors."

The California Vehicle Code, Section 22500, states in part:
"For Prohibited Stopping, Standing, or Parking: No person shall stop, park, or leave standing any vehicle whether attended or unattended, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a peace officer or official traffic control device, in any of the
following places:
(g) Alongside or opposite any street or highway excavation or obstruction when stopping, standing, or parking would obstruct traffic.
(i) Except as provided under Section 22500.5, alongside curb space authorized for the loading and unloading of passengers of a bus engaged as a common carrier in local transportation when indicated by a sign or red paint on the curb erected or painted by local authorities pursuant to an ordinance."

In Section 627 the Vehicle Code provides a definition for "Engineering and Traffic Survey", and states that an "Engineering and Traffic Survey" shall include:

1. Prevailing speeds as determined by traffic engineering measurements.
2. Accident records.
3. Highway, traffic, and roadside conditions not readily apparent to the driver.

In addition, the 2003 edition of the Vehicle Code added that residential density, and pedestrian and bicycle safety may be considered.

In defining a "Residence District", Section 515 of the California Vehicle Code states: "A "Residence District" is that portion of a highway and the property contiguous thereto, other than a business district, (a) upon one side of which highway, within a distance of a quarter of a mile, the contiguous property fronting thereon is occupied by 13 or more separate dwelling houses or business structures, or (b) upon both sides of which highway, collectively, within a distance of a quarter of a mile, the contiguous property fronting thereon is occupied by 16 or more separate dwelling houses or business structures. A residence district may be longer than one-quarter of a mile if the above ratio of separate dwelling houses or business structures to the length of the highway exists."

Casa Largo Way does not meet the minimum housing density requirements necessary to qualify for a 25 mile per hour Prime Facie "Residence District" requirements.

## FIELD REVIEW AND OBSERVATION:

Casa Largo Way is a local subdivision roadway that terminates at an "ALL WAY STOP" at the Merrychase Drive intersection, which adjoins the main access to the Blue Oak Elementary School. Two (2) school crosswalks exist at the Merrychase/Casa Largo Way intersection; one (1) crossing Casa Largo Way and the other crossing Merrychase Drive, on the northern side of this intersection (see following exhibit). Casa Largo Way has an overall width of 26 feet. Prior to and after school, parents park along both sides of Casa Largo Way to pick up or drop off children at school. As a result, with vehicles parked on both sides of the roadway, Casa Largo Way is reduced to an average roadway width of 10 feet and functions as a one (1) lane roadway.


Both the Cameron Park Fire Department and the Blue Oak Elementary School Administration is in support of the requested parking restriction on Casa Largo Way (see attached emails).

## FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS:

## FINDINGS

Casa Largo Way has been found to have the following:

- Overall road width of 26 feet with four (4) foot wide sidewalks
- The estimated average daily traffic volume is 500 vehicles per day
- Roadway is straight, level, and 0.03 of a mile in length
- There were no accidents reported along Casa Largo Way for the three (3) year period from January, 2011, through December, 2013

Crosswalks are present crossing Casa Largo Way as well as the northern side of Merrychase Drive at this intersection. Prior to and after School, parents park along both sides of Casa Largo Way to drop off or pick up children at school. As a result, with vehicles parked on both sides of the roadway, Casa Largo Way is reduced to an average drivable roadway width of 10 feet and functions as a one (1) lane roadway. Restricting parking on one (1) side of Casa Largo Way will help balance the need for parking adjoining the school in addition to maintaining the function of Casa Largo Way as a two (2) lane roadway. Roadside parking would be best suited on the north side of Casa Largo Way, which coincides with the northern crosswalk on Merrychase Drive (see prior exhibit). The representatives of the petitioners of the Oak Crest Subdivision were notified that if the parking restriction on Casa Largo Way was approved and installed, it would result in additional roadside parking on Gailey Circle. The Oak Crest Subdivision representatives did not express any concern of the potential additional roadside parking on Gailey Circle as a result of the proposed parking restriction on Casa Largo Way. Furthermore, no parking zones at driveways that exist along Gailey Circle will prevent a similar roadway narrowing condition that exists on Casa Largo Way.

## CONCLUSIONS

Restricting parking on the south side of Casa Largo Way will help maintain the function of Casa Largo Way as a two (2) lane roadway prior to and after school. The Oak Crest Subdivision representatives did not express any concern of the potential additional roadside parking on Gailey Circle as a result of the proposed parking restriction on Casa Largo Way.

## RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. That the Traffic Advisory Committee approves the request for the installation of "No Parking Anytime" signs and red curbing on the entire southern side of Casa Largo Way."
2. That the Board of Supervisors be requested to adopt a Resolution, pursuant to Section 10.12.010, of the El Dorado County Ordinance Code, to sanction the installation of the "No Parking Anytime" signs on the southern side of Casa Largo Way from mile post 0.00 to 0.03 :

BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution No. 252-81, which establishes "No Parking" zones pursuant to Section 10.12.010 of the El Dorado County Ordinance Code, is amended as follows:

## ADD:

( ) "No Parking Any Time" along the entire length of Casa Largo Way on the south side of the roadway, milpost 0.00 to 0.03 .

(f) deleted by ordinance number 1783, dated April 26, 1977.
(g) Upon either side of the main street of the Townsite of

El Dorado between its intersection with State Highway Route No. 65 (Sign Route 49) and its intersection with County Highway No. 1861 (unnamed street) except wholly within the white lines designating parking spaces painted upon the road surface.
(h) Upon either side of the alley in the Townsite of El Dorado from its intersection with the main street of El Dorado, approximately 75 feet easterly of the intersection of Main and Church Streets to a line 100 feet northerly of and parallel to the center of said Main Street, except wholly within the white lines designating parking spaces painted upon the road surface.
(i) Upon either side of Church Street, Missouri Street and Hinman Alley from their intersection with the main street in the Townsite of El Dorado, to a line 100 feet distant and parallel to the center of said main street.
(j) deleted by ordinance number 1783, dated April 26, 1977.
(k) deleted by ordinance number 1783, dated April 26, 1977.
(1) Upon either side of Ponderosa Road adjacent to the Ponderosa High School property between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., excluding Saturdays, Sundays and holidays.
(m) Upon either side of Bacchi Road running the entire length thereof.
( $n$ ) Upon either side of Lillyama Road trunning the entire length thereof.
(o) Upon either side of Pedro Hill Road running the entire length thereof.
(p) Upon either side of Salmon Falls Road from Síate Route 49 to a point one mile south thereof.
(q) Upon either side of Rattlesnake Bar Road from State koute 49 West to Pilot Creek.
(r) Upon any portion of State Highway 49 directly in front of the United States Post Office located at Diamond Springs, Calif.
(s) Upon either side of Echo Summit Road (County Road No. 116) from the upper parking lot to Echo Lake, a distance of approximately 1,000 feet, except within the white lines designating parking spaces or on the shoulder side outside of white lines designating the edge of the roadway. (Ordinance No. 1905, 8/8/78)
( $t$ ) Upon the entire length of the Easterly side of Remington Street, South Lake Tahoe. (9/5/78, Ord. No. 1917)
(u) Upon that portion of Tam O'Shanter Drive lying between Unit No. 4 and Unit No. 2 of St. Andrew's Village subdivision between the hours of 2:00 o'clock a.m. and 6:00 o'clock a.m. daily. (Ord. No. 1982)
(v) Upon either side of Fir Street (No. 1601) between State Highway 50 and Margaret Drive. (Ord. No. 2049, 1/8/80)
(w) Upon the easterly side of Missouri Flat Road from the intersection with Headington Road to a point 100 feet north. (Ord. No. 2057)
(x) Upon the northerly side of Green Valley Road from a point 235 feet west of the entrance to Browns Ravine to a point 150 feet east of said entrance. (Ord. No. 2096, 6/3/80)
