




REDUCING AND PREVENTING CRIME BY BUILDING STRONGER MEMBERS OF OUR COMMUNITIES.

- Both are employed in EDC, one works with BBBS





PROBATION OPERATES TRANSITIONAL HOUSING

OUR TRANSITIONAL HOUSING WILL ADDRESS A LONG-STANDING NEED OF OUR COMMUNITY AND AN IMPORTANT STABILIZATION FACTOR

THIS HOUSE WAS MADE POSSIBLE THROUGH A STRATEGIC COLLABORATION BETWEEN HHSA, CCC, LOCAL CBO, & CONTINUES TO SEEK PARTNERSHIPS WITH COMMUNITY HEALTH OR MARSHALL HOSPITAL MEDICATION-ASSISTED TREATMENT (MAT) PROGRAM, NCCT, CENTER FOR VIOLENCE-FREE RELATIONSHIPS, & ONLY KINDNESS.
