



RESOLUTION NO.

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

***A RESOLUTION DECLARING PROPERTY OWNERS AFFECTED BY THE ANGORA FIRE
TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR PERMIT FEE WAIVERS***

- WHEREAS, The County proclaimed a local emergency due to the outbreak of the Angora Fire on Sunday, June 23, and the Board of Supervisors ratified said action on Tuesday, June 26; and*
- WHEREAS, As of Thursday, June 28, 2007, 254 residences and ~~75 commercial structures~~ have been destroyed, and ~~another 14 residences have been damaged~~; and*
- WHEREAS, As a result of the Angora fire, serious health and safety hazards currently exist from fire debris, including unstable chimneys, walls of fire damaged structures, and harmful chemicals that are likely to remain on affected parcels, such hazards requiring immediate attention and constituting a local emergency; and*
- WHEREAS, the expeditious demolition of damaged structures and facilitation of the rebuilding and upgrading of the structures, including making the structures more fire-resistant, is in the best interest of the citizens of El Dorado County; and*
- WHEREAS, The provision of fee waivers will provide critical relief to victims of the recent fires in the unincorporated area of the Tahoe basin, expedite the permitting process and waive permit fees for legally built structures that have been destroyed; such relief is deemed to serve a public purpose; and*
- WHEREAS, Section 15.16.020 of the El Dorado County Code states that "all matters pertaining to fees are as established by resolution of the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors."*

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that,

- Section 1. The Board of Supervisors hereby waives all County permit fees associated with property owners removing, repairing and/or rebuilding the equivalent square footage of previously existing and damaged homes and structures (including accessory buildings) within the burn areas of the Angora Fire.*
- Section 2. Permit fee waivers will be granted one time for each affected parcel to the property owner of record at the time of the Angora Fire.*

Section 3. All such County permit applications must be submitted to the Development Services Department by December 23, 2008.
