



RESOLUTION NO. 129-2008

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, County Code Chapter 2.42 Sec 080 of the County of El Dorado empowers the Director of Emergency Services to proclaim the existence of a local emergency when said County is affected or likely to be affected by a public calamity and the County Board of Supervisors is not in session, and;

WHEREAS, the Director of Emergency Services of the County El Dorado does hereby find; That conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property have arisen within said county, caused by severe wildland fire which has brought damage to acreage, structures, and caused emergency evacuations, and has the potential for causing extensive damages to property and threatening the safety of the public; and

That these conditions are or likely to be beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of said County, and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a local emergency now exists throughout the County due to the extreme fire danger conditions,
