**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE USE OF HIGHWAYS  
FOR THE LAKE TAHOE TRIATHLON  
August 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2015**

**WHEREAS**, Big Blue Adventure proposes to conduct the **Lake Tahoe Triathlon** event Saturday, August 22<sup>nd</sup> and Sunday, August 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2015; and,

**WHEREAS**, the El Dorado County Sheriff's Office and the California Highway Patrol will be on site for traffic control and to mitigate traffic impacts as arranged by the event coordinator; and,

**WHEREAS**, the cycling and running events scheduled for the Lake Tahoe Triathlon will travel along State Highway 89 between the hours of 6:30am and 1:00pm with possible road restrictions.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Supervisors for the County of El Dorado acknowledges and accepts that road restrictions could occur during the Lake Tahoe Triathlon on August 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup>.

Here is information for the Lake Tahoe Triathlon scheduled for Saturday and Sunday August 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2015.

**Saturday August 22, 2015**

Requesting CHP Officers for the following locations.

**1. Location #1 Two Officers**  
 Entrance/exit to Sugar Pine State Park (lake side)

- a. What happens here?
  - i. Cyclists will head out of the transition area after swimming on the State Park road and then
    - 1. Turn left/south onto route 89 to a CHP staffed turnaround approximately 5 miles south
- b. Event Timeline
  - i. First cyclist 0710 hrs.
  - ii. Last cyclist 0810 hrs.
- c. CHP Officer Timeline
  - i. Arrive location #1 0645 hrs.
  - ii. Complete location #1 0830 hrs.
- d. Traffic control
  - i. Intermittently control NB and SB route 89 traffic to allow cyclists to turn left/south onto HWY 89.

**2. Location #6 Two Officers**  
 Sprint Bike Turnaround approximately five miles south of state park entrance. This location is between 3 Ring and 2 Ring Road. The exact location is TBD during a scout with CHP one month prior to the event.

- a. What happens here?

- i. Sprint course cyclists turnaround and head back to the transition area at Sugar Pine State Park
- b. Event Timeline
  - i. First Sprint Cyclist 0750 hrs.
  - ii. Last Sprint Cyclist 0830 hrs.
- c. CHP Officer Timeline
  - i. Arrive location #6 0720 hrs.
  - ii. Complete location #6 0845 hrs.
- d. Traffic control
  - i. Intermittently control NB and SB route 89 traffic to allow cyclists to turnaround from south to northbound

**Sunday August 23, 2015**

Requesting CHP Officers for the following locations.

**3. Location #1 Two Officers Move to Location #5 once completed**  
Entrance/exit to Sugar Pine State Park (lake side)

- a. What happens here?
  - i. Cyclists head out of Sugar Pine State Park "East" and then
    - 1. Turn right/north onto 89 if Half/Long course
    - 2. Turn left/south onto route 89 if Olympic course
- b. Event Timeline
  - i. First cyclist 0725 hrs.
  - ii. Last cyclist 0810 hrs.
- c. CHP Officer Timeline
  - i. Arrive location #1 0655 hrs.
  - ii. Complete location #1 0820 hrs.
- d. Traffic control
  - i. Intermittently control NB and SB route 89 traffic to allow cyclists to turn left/south and right/north onto route 89

**4. Location #2 Two Officers**  
North Bike Turnaround 89 at Ward Creek Bridge

- a. What happens here?
  - i. Half/Long course cyclist turnaround from NB to SB lane here twice
    - 1. Turnaround from NB to SB lane
- b. Event Timeline
  - i. First cyclist 0745 hrs.
  - ii. Last cyclist 0915 hrs.
- c. CHP Officer Timeline
  - i. Arrive location #2 0715 hrs.

ii. Complete location #2 0945 hrs.

d. Traffic control

- i. Intermittently control NB and SB route 89 traffic to allow cyclists to turnaround from NB to SB lanes

**5. Location #3 Two Officers**

South Half/Long Lap Bike Turnaround 89 just north of Sugar Pine east entrance

a. What happens here?

- i. Half/Long course cyclist turnaround from SB to NB once  
1. Turnaround from SB to NB

b. Event Timeline

- i. First cyclist 0800 hrs.  
ii. Last cyclist 0930 hrs.

c. CHP Officer Timeline

- i. Arrive location #3 0730 hrs.  
ii. Complete location #3 1000 hrs.

d. Traffic control

- i. Intermittently control NB and SB route 89 traffic to allow cyclists to turnaround from SB to NB lane

**6. Location #4 Two Officers**

Half and Olympic bike course turnaround approximately twelve miles Sugar Pine Park east entrance. This location is approximately 1200' north of Baldwin Beach Road on Route 89. The exact location is TBD during a scout with CHP one month prior to the event.

a. What happens here?

- i. All Half and Olympic cyclists turnaround here once and head back to the transition area at Sugar Pine State Park

b. Event Timeline

- i. First Cyclist 0800 hrs.  
ii. Last Cyclist 1100 hrs.

c. CHP Officer Timeline

- i. Arrive location #4 0730 hrs.  
ii. Complete location #4 1130 hrs.

d. Traffic control

- i. Intermittently control NB and SB route 89 traffic to allow cyclists to turnaround from SB to NB lane

**7. Location #5 Two Officers**

Run crossing at the path between the two Sugar Pine State Park entrances

a. What happens here?

- i. Runners from the Half and Olympic courses will cross route 89 where the paved

State Park trail emerges on both sides of route 89. This is located between the two Sugar Pine State Park entrances (lake side and campground side). Sprint course runners stay on the east side of 89 and do not cross.

- b. Event Timeline
  - i. First runner 0900 hrs.
  - ii. Last runner 1215 hrs.
  
- c. CHP Officer Timeline
  - i. Arrive location #5 0830 hrs.
  - ii. Complete location #5 1230 hrs.
  
- d. Traffic control
  - i. Intermittently control NB and SB route 89 traffic to allow runners to cross 89

**Event Staff**

Sweeper

A sweeper (event staff on motorcycle) will follow the last cyclist in all distance events. They will notify the CHP officer(s) of the last cyclist. Once the sweeper comes to the traffic control location, traffic control can end.

Sprint and Olympic Bike Turnaround

One event staff will be located at the sprint and Half/Olympic bike turnaround locations to assist CHP if requested.

Run Crossing

Event staff will assist the CHP officer at this location if needed. Event staff can call out when runners are approaching the intersection. The event is spread out at this point and there could be minutes between runner crossings.
