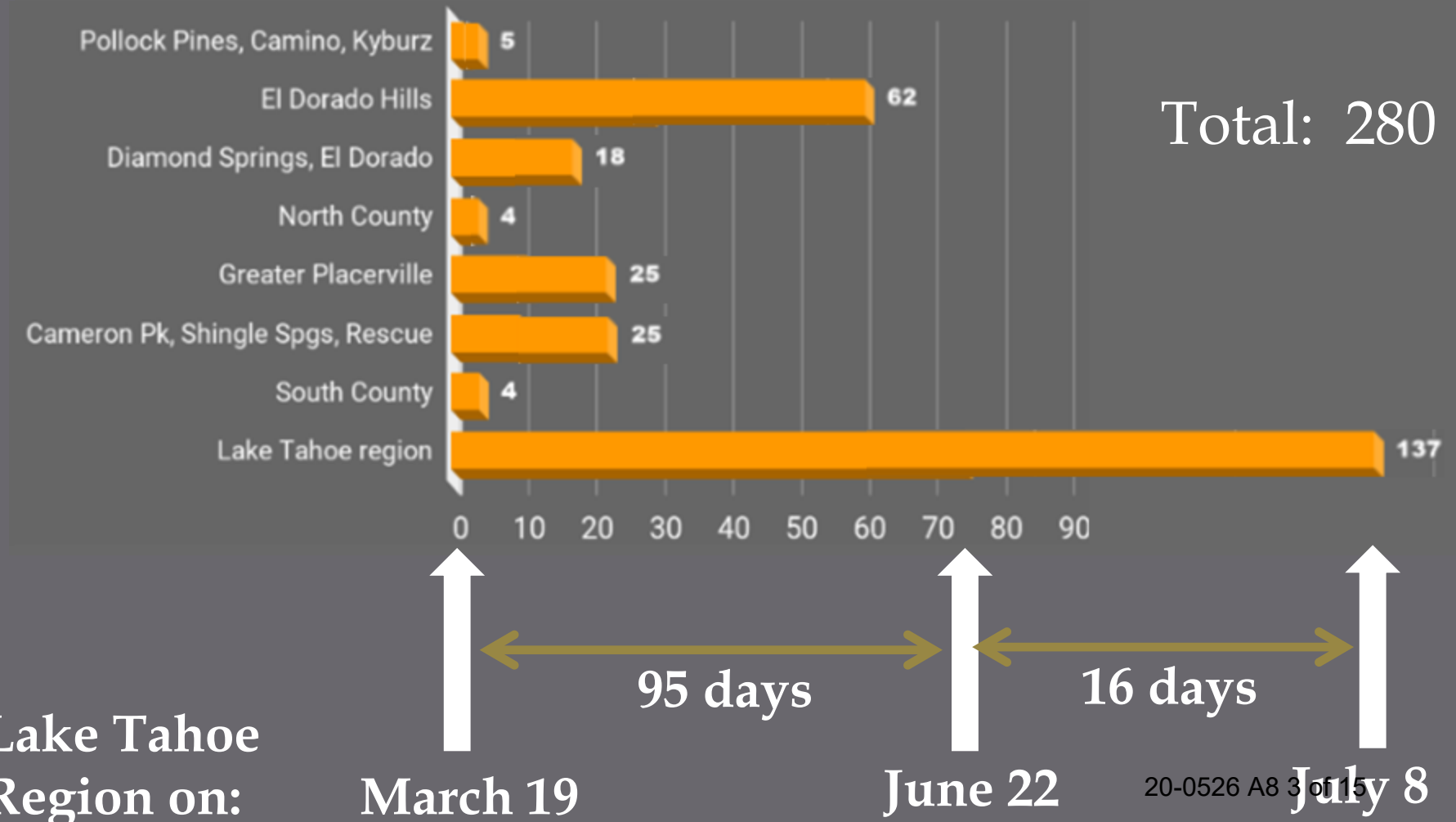

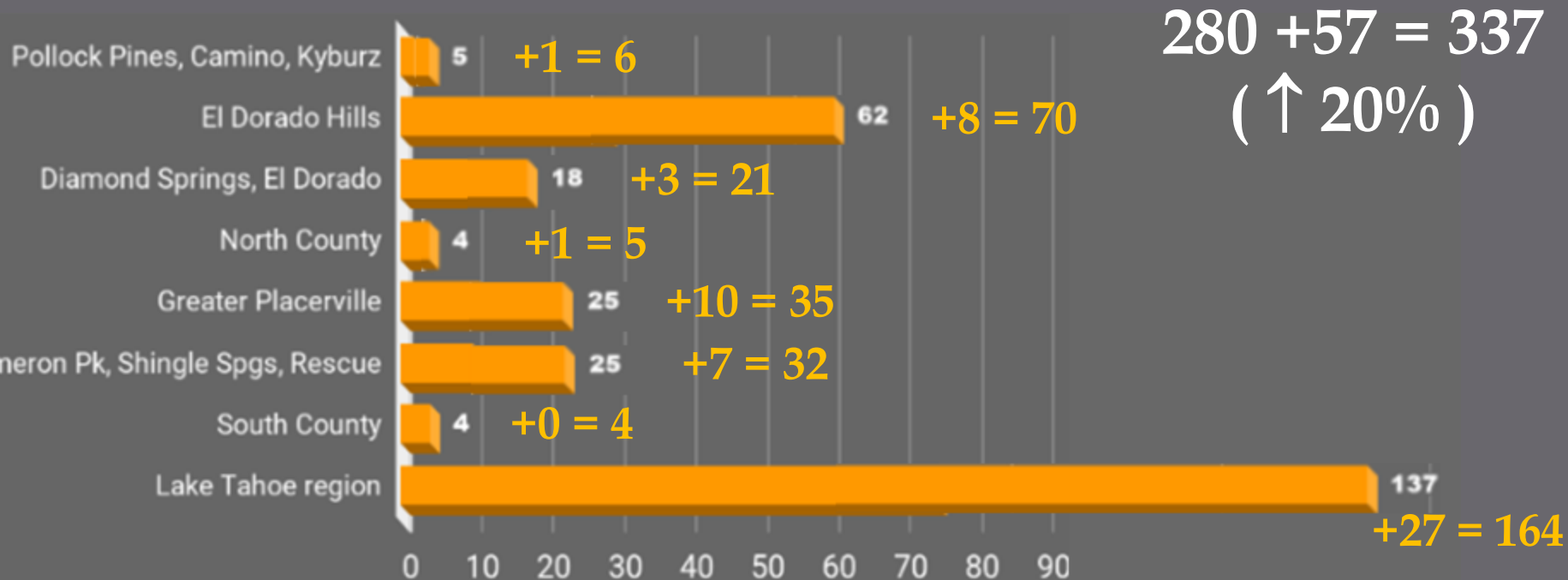

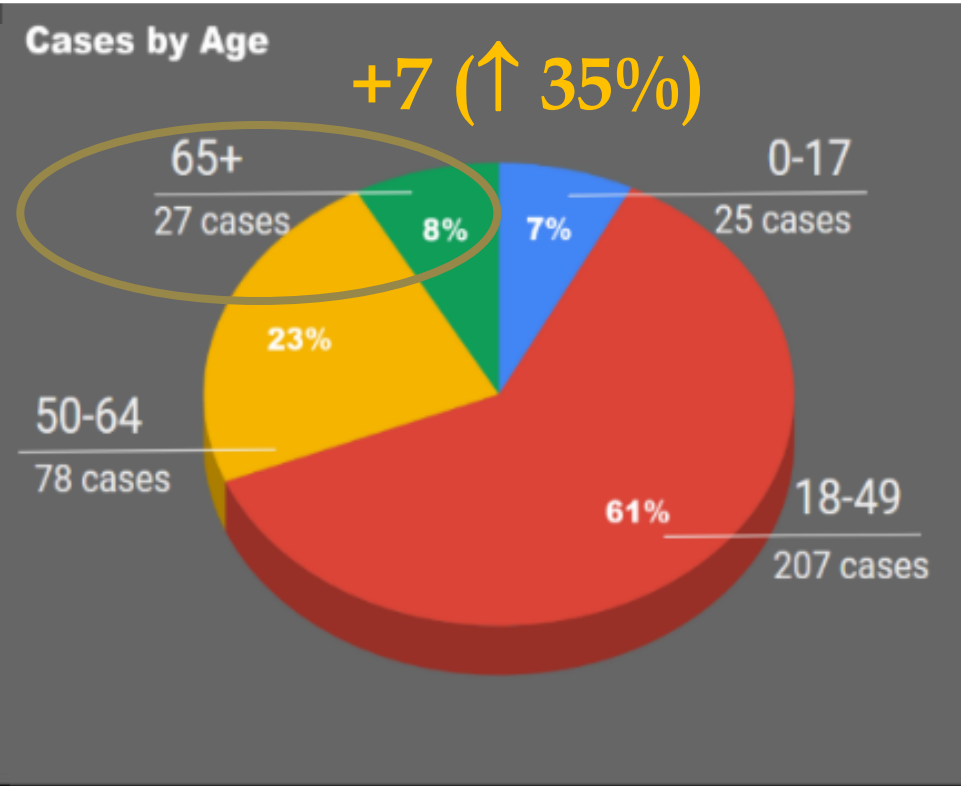
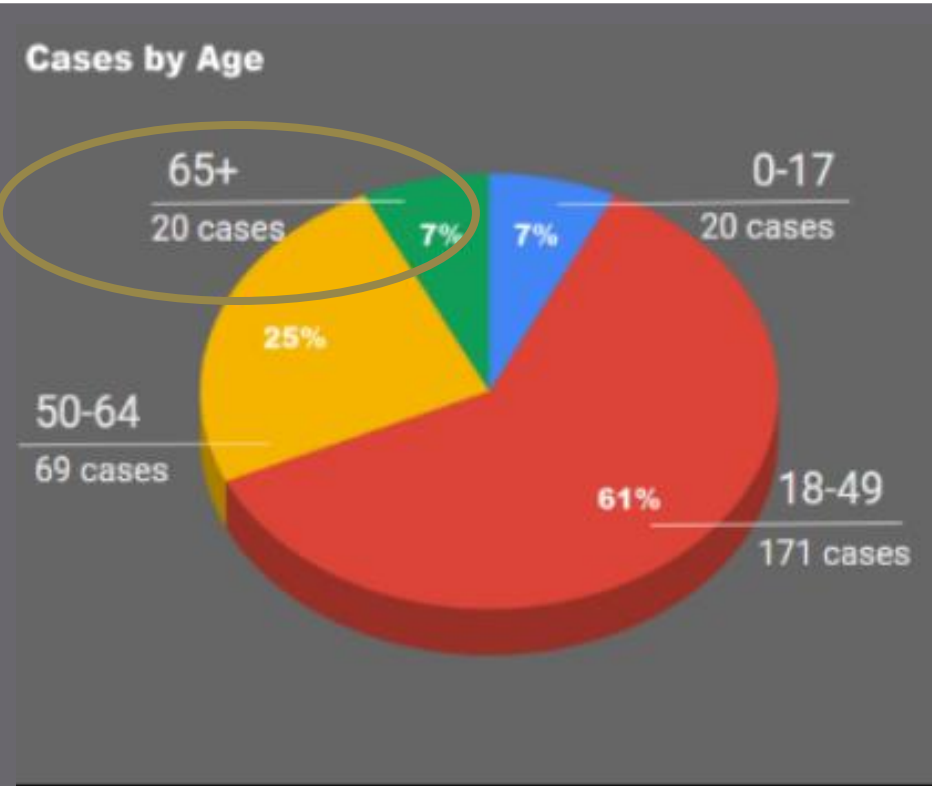

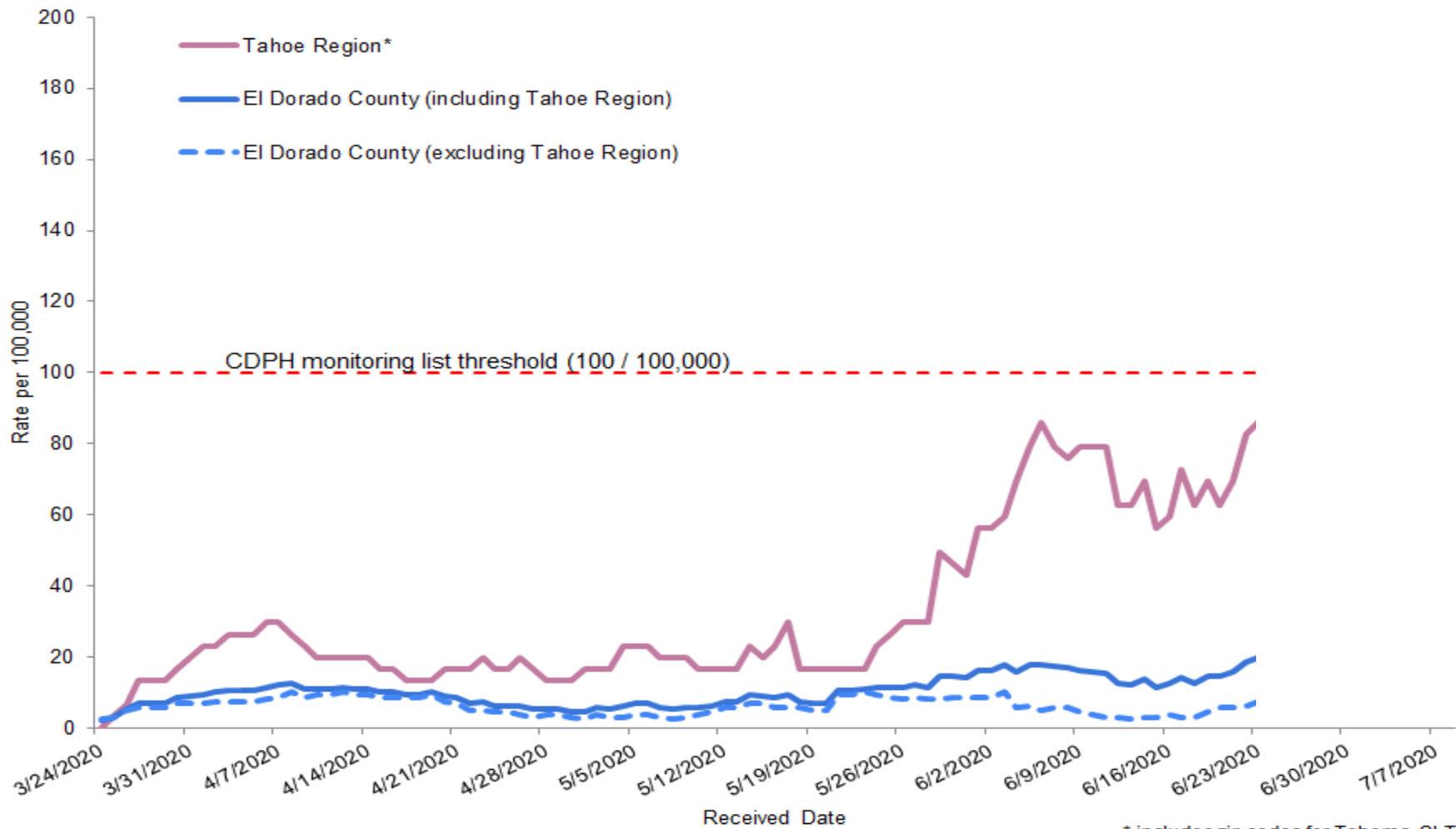

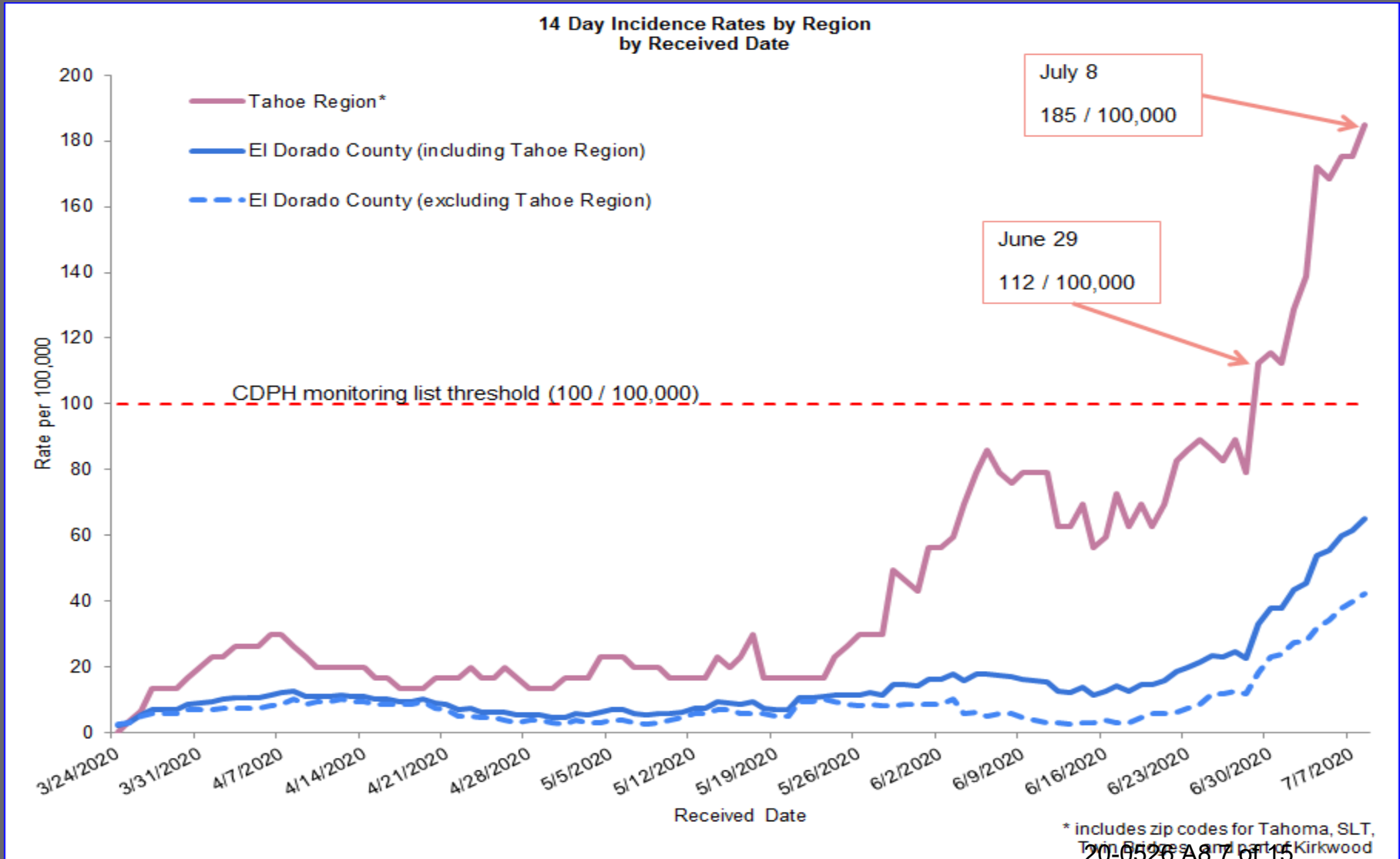
14 Day Incidence Rates by Region

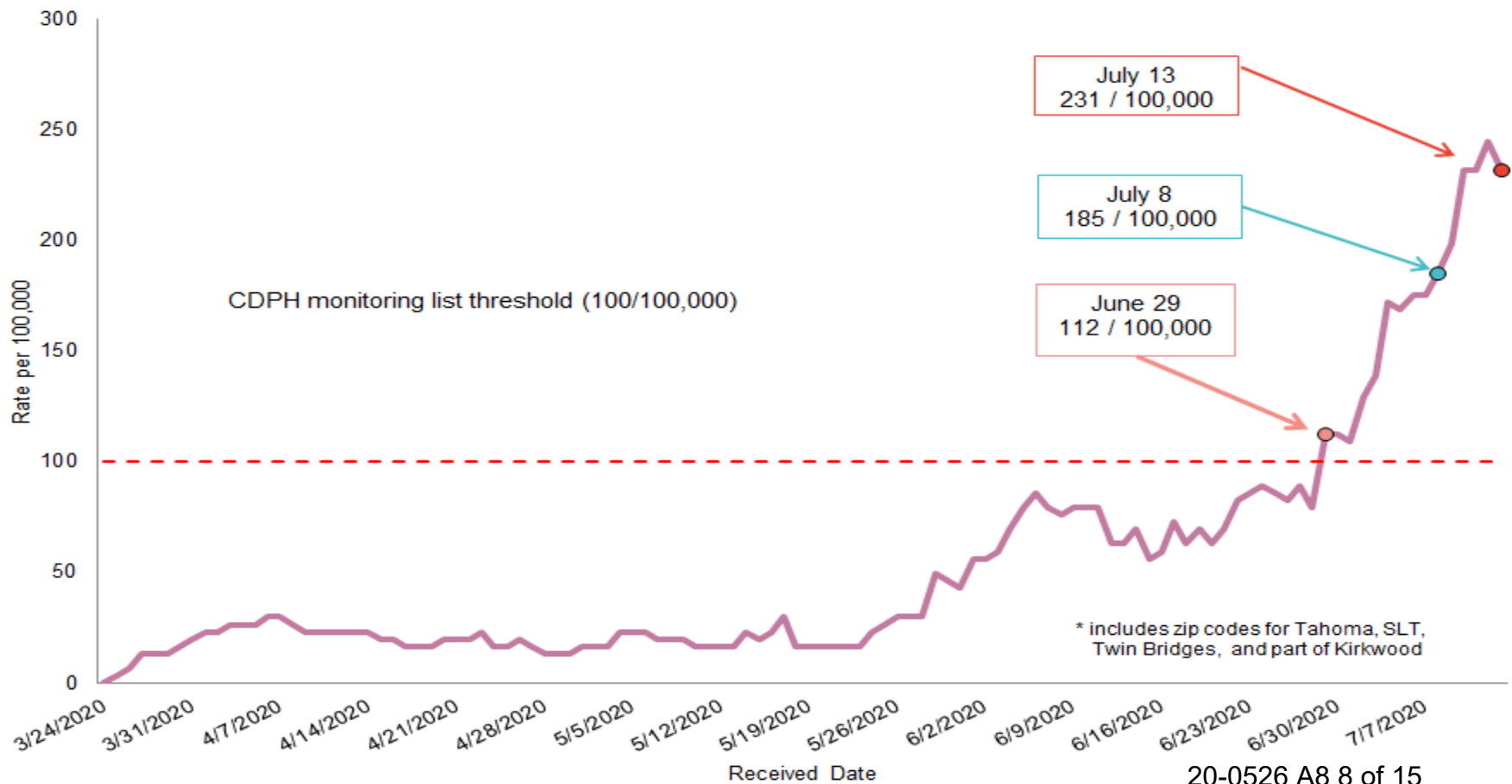

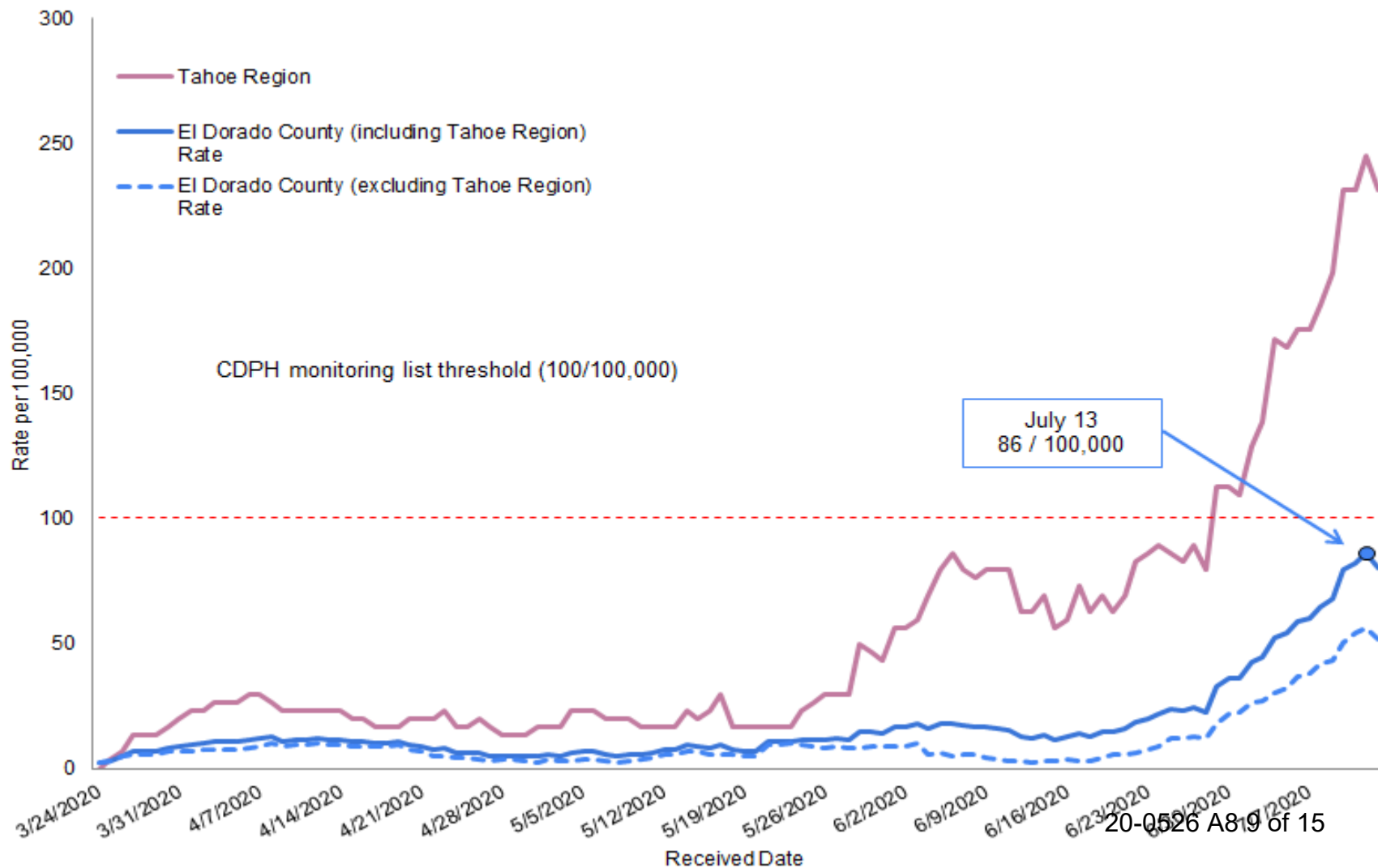
14 Day Incidence Rates by Region South Lake Tahoe Region* by Received Date

What's new statewide?

Effective July 13, 2020, ALL counties must close indoor operations in these sectors:

- Dine-in restaurants
- Wineries and tasting rooms
- Movie theaters
- Family entertainment centers (for example: bowling alleys, miniature golf, batting cages and arcades)
- Zoos and museums
- Cardrooms

What's new statewide?

Additionally,

- bars
- brewpubs
- breweries
- pubs

must close all operations both indoor and outdoor statewide, unless they are offering sit-down, outdoor dine-in meals.

Alcohol can only be sold in the same transaction as a meal.

What's new elsewhere?

Counties on Monitoring List for 3 consecutive days required to shut down the following:

- Offices for non-essential sectors
- Personal care services, like nail salons, body waxing and tattoo parlors
- Hair salons and barbershops
- Worship services
- Fitness centers
- Protests
- Malls

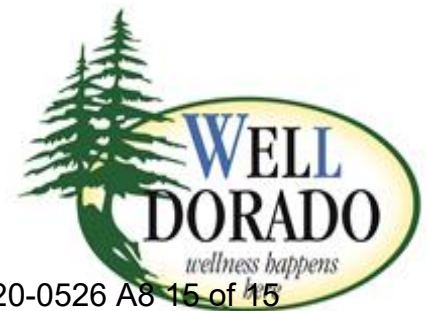
