DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT The work done is shown on the Plans, and generally consisted of, but is not limited to the following: Construction of erosion control improvements included curb and gutter with tie-in pavement, a double sediment trap, drainage channel, and revegetation. In addition the Work included grading, widening of the roadway, rock slope protection, and guardrail removal and installation and construction of Angora Creek improvements included clearing and grubbing, tree removal, steel sheet pile removal and relocation, log trash rack removal, mowing and sod harvesting, construction of temporary access roads, dewatering and diversion of Angora Creek, construction of new creek channel, floodplain grading, rewatering, revegetation, earthen berm removal, culvert removal, installation of precast bridge structure and cast-in-place foundations at Lake Tahoe Boulevard, and utility relocation.			
LOCATION OF PROJECT: The Project area is located in eastern El Dorado County, in the Tahoe Basin, where Angora Creek passes beneath Lake Tahoe Boulevard. The Project area is generally contained within the floodplain of Angora Creek, approximately 60 feet downstream and 120 feet upstream of Lake Tahoe Boulevard.
