Resolution Adopting the Public Housing Authority Budget Of the County of El Dorado for Fiscal Year 2023-2024

WHEREAS, Chapter 1, Division 3, Title 3 of the California Government Code beginning with Section 29000 provides the procedure for counties to follow in adopting their annual budgets; and

WHEREAS, after providing due and legal notice, the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado, State of California, has held the required public hearings, during which time additions and deletions to the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Recommended Budget were made, and are incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, said hearings were conducted on June 13, 2023, in the Board of Supervisors Chambers in Placerville, California.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in accordance with Section 29090 et seq., of the Government Code, the Board of Supervisors for the County of El Dorado does hereby adopt the Budgets for Fiscal Year 2023-2024, including the Public Housing Authority budget, by reference of the Recommended Budget and as amended by the Board of Supervisors during the budget hearing and summarized in Attachment A to this Resolution, and hereby authorize the Chief Administrative Officer and Auditor-Controller to make adjustments to various fund budgets in order to balance the final fund balance amounts as derived through the closing of books and audit adjustments.
