natural resources, environment management, people who live here, parks, trails, boating, fishing, hiking, camping, skiing - water & snow, tourism – recreation "play", recreate outside baseball, soccer, football, softball, swimming, lacrosse, basketball, tennis, golf, whitewater rafting river "stuff", 4-wheel drive, Trains, tennis, golf, basketball, equestrian, walking, hiking, bird watching, native plants, bicycling, hang gliding, sailing, gold panning, historical tourism, museum, Gold Bug mine, historical RR museum, Sutter's Mill, Wine tasting, Artistically caring for handicapping needs access.
