

## 205. Setting of Meetings

The Board of Supervisors shall provide by ordinance for the frequency, manner and time of holding all regular and special meetings. The Board of Supervisors is required, if requested by any of the supervisors before the adoption of the annual calendar of the regular meetings of the board, to hold one meeting per calendar year in that supervisorial district.

The Board of Supervisors shall provide by ordinance for the frequency, manner and time of holding all regular and special meetings. The Board of Supervisors is required, if requested by any of the supervisors before the adoption of the annual calendar of the regular meetings of the board, encouraged to hold one meeting per calendar year in thateach supervisorial district.

## For reference:

### El Dorado County Ordinance Code Section 2.03.020. Time, date and location.

The times, dates and locations of all regular meetings of the Board of Supervisors shall be set, and, if necessary, subsequently changed, by resolution of the Board. Special meetings shall be set in accordance with Government Code § 54956 and emergency meetings shall be set in accordance with Government Code § 54956.5. In accordance with El Dorado County Charter Section 205, the Board will endeavor to hold one meeting per calendar year in each supervisorial district.

### California Government Code Section 25081

By ordinance the board shall provide for the holding of regular meetings of the board at the county seat.

The board may change the place for the holding of one or more regular meetings of the board to a location within the county other than the county seat if both of the following occur:

(a) The change of location of the regular meeting of the board is adopted by ordinance, resolution, bylaw, or other rule required for the conduct of business by the body at a regular meeting of the body.

(b) Notice of the location change is posted in a location that is freely accessible to the public no later than the prior regular meeting of the board.
