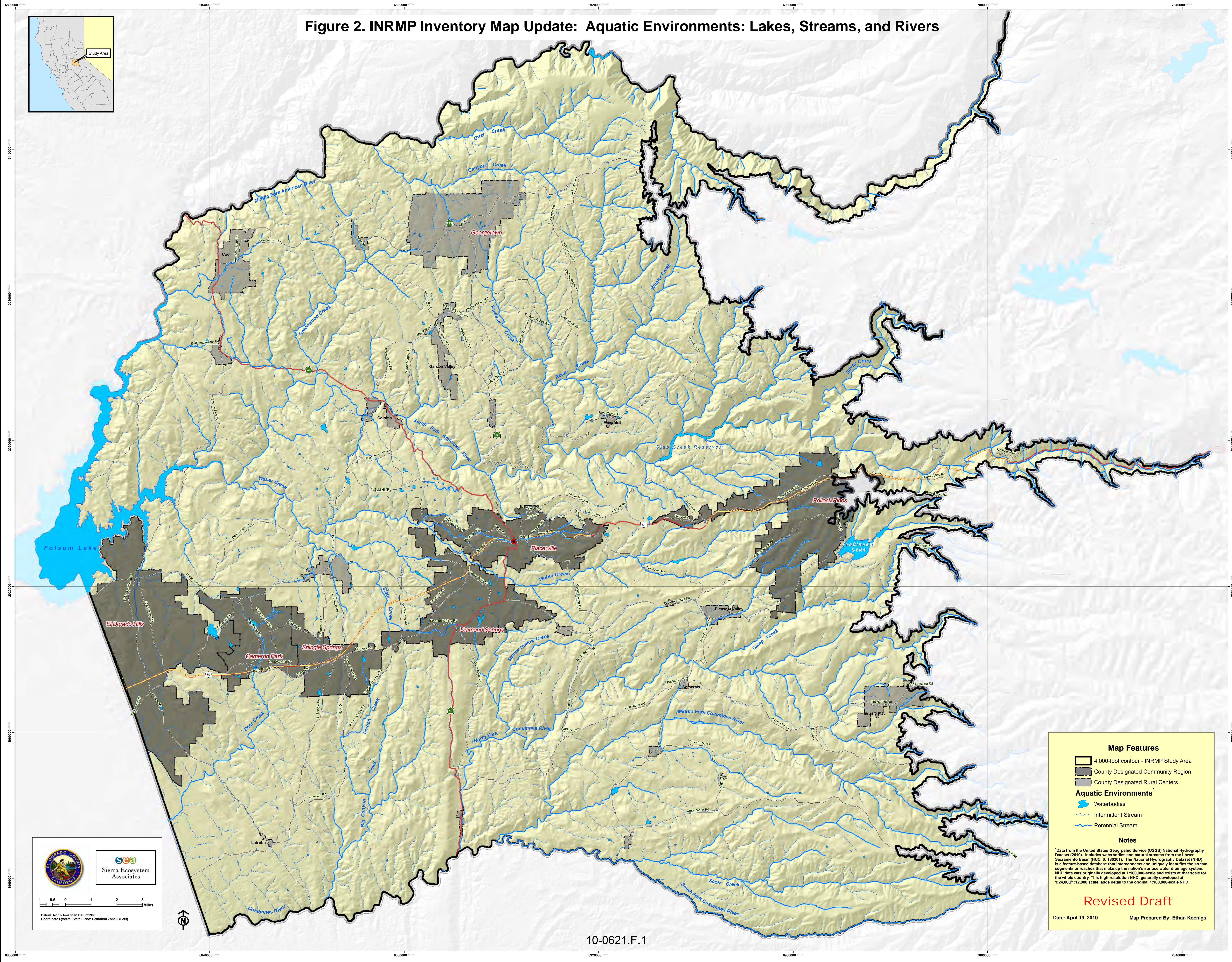


Figure 2. INRMP Inventory Map Update: Aquatic Environments: Lakes, Streams, and Rivers

¹Data from the United States Geographic Service (USGS) National Hydrography Dataset (2010). Includes waterbodies and natural streams from the Lower Sacramento Basin (HUC 5: 180201). The National Hydrography Dataset (NHD) is a feature-based database that interconnects and uniquely identifies the stream segments or reaches that make up the nation's surface water drainage system. NHD data was originally developed at 1:100,000-scale and exists at that scale for the whole country. This high-resolution NHD, generally developed at 1:24,000-1:12,000 scale, adds detail to the original 1:100,000-scale NHD.
