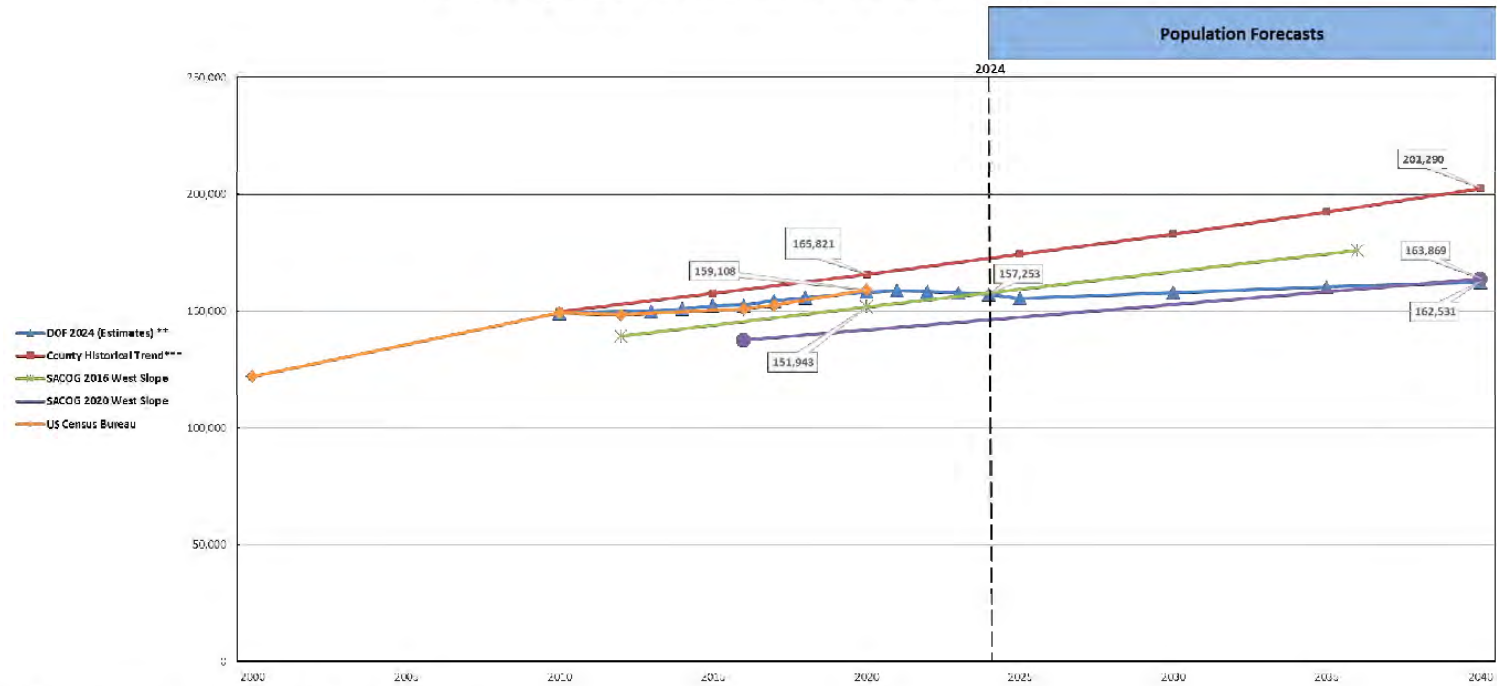


El Dorado County Population Data and Forecasts Through 2040*

* Includes SACOG 2040 population projection. General Plan time horizon is 2025.

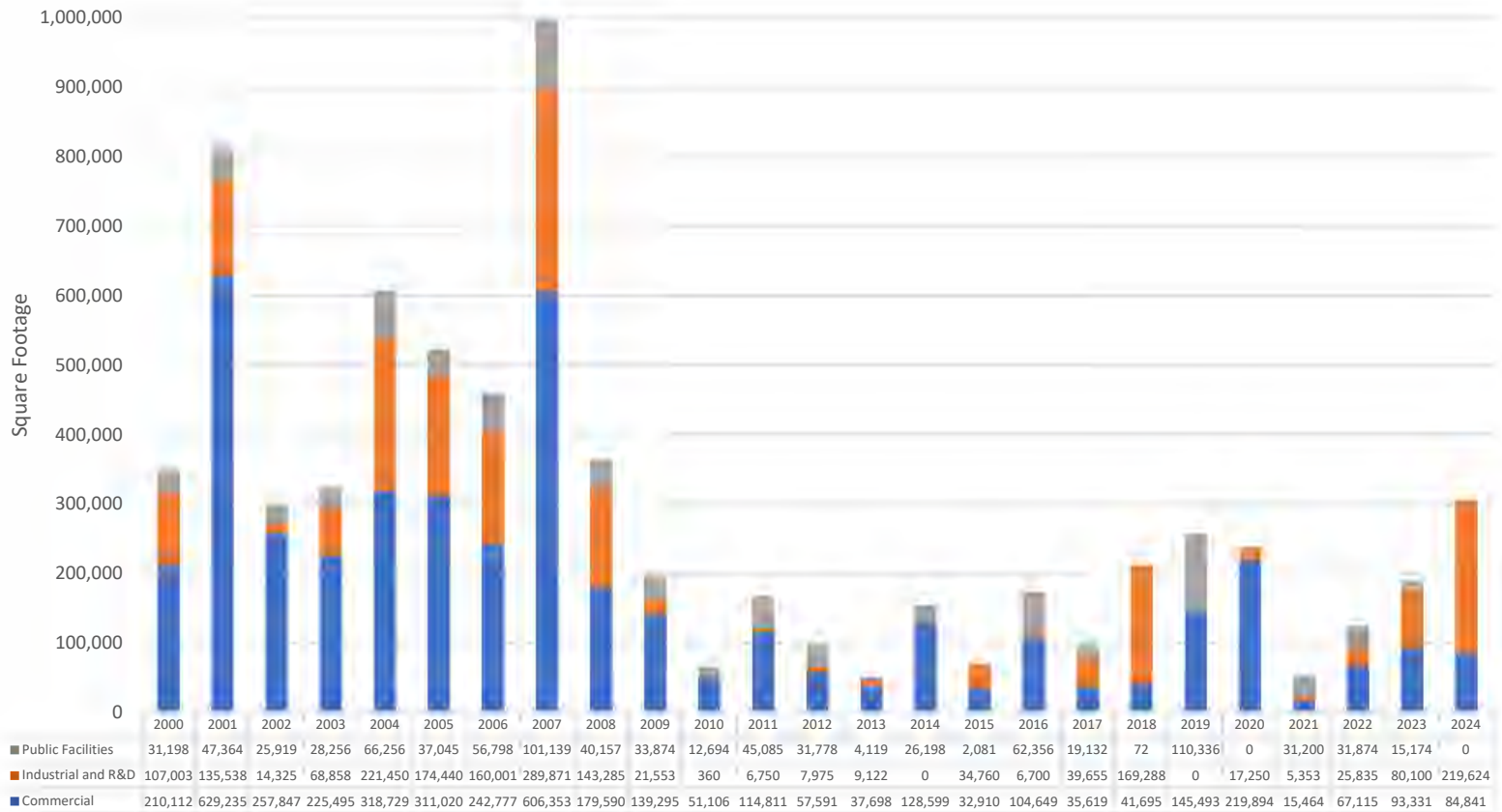
