Topic	District-Specific Matters
Rationale	The Board, together with the CAO, is the County's governance team and the entire board is the unit of authority; however, each member is elected by their district. Each district includes distinct communities, and each supervisor has a deep connection and understanding of their district and its communities.
Protocol	Board Members respect the unique connection a Supervisor has to their home district. Supervisors will refrain from initiating involvement in issues or concerns specific to another Supervisorial district without first discussing such involvement with the appropriate Supervisor.
	Supervisors will inform the entire Board, through the Board meeting process, of constituent issues and concerns they are involved with in their districts that may have a countywide impact.
