Topic	District-Specific Matters
Rationale	The Board, together with the CAO, is the County's governance team and the entire board is the unit of authority; however, each member is elected by their district. Each district includes distinct communities, and each supervisor has a deep connection and understanding of their district and its communities.
Protocol	<p>Board Members respect the unique connection a Supervisor has to their home district.</p> <p>Supervisors will refrain from initiating involvement in issues or concerns specific to another Supervisorial district without first discussing such involvement with the appropriate Supervisor.</p> <p>Supervisors will inform the entire Board, through the Board meeting process, of constituent issues and concerns they are involved with in their districts that may have a countywide impact.</p>
