


Dear Members of the Board:

Recommendations:

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends that the Board of Supervisors:

1. Award the Construction Contract for the Cameron Park Drive and Coach Lane Intersection Improvements to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder Yubacon, Inc. with a bid of \$314,617.78; and,
2. Authorize the Board Chairman to sign the Contract Agreement between the County of El Dorado and Yubacon, Inc. subject to review and approval of the final contract documents by County Counsel and Risk Management.

Reasons for Recommendations:

On September 26, 2006, your Board authorized the advertisement for construction bids for the Cameron Park Drive and Coach Lane Intersection Improvements. On October 26, 2006 the Department received two (2) bid proposals for this project.

Department staff has reviewed both of the bids and have determined Yubacon, Inc. has submitted a responsive bid and is the apparent low responsible bidder for this project.

The low bid was 11.8% higher than the engineer's estimate of \$281,472; but is reasonable given the end of construction season time frame and a continued competitive market.

Staff is recommending the project be awarded at this time to Yubacon, Inc.

Fiscal Impact:

The cost associated for the construction phase of this project is estimated at \$437,000, which includes the bid of approximately \$315,000; supplemental items at \$22,000 (dust control, water pollution control and flagging); construction management, inspection, and surveying at \$53,500 and a contingency (unanticipated change orders) of \$47,200.

Funding for this project will be from 2004 General Plan Traffic Impact Mitigation Fee program, Non-El Dorado Hills local road component. Sufficient funds are available in the fund for the project. The project is included in the 06/07 CIP budget.

Net County Cost:


There is no cost to the County General Fund associated with this agenda item.

Action to be Taken Following Approval:

Upon approval of the award of the Construction Contract:

1. The Department will forward the approved Construction Contract to Yubacon, Inc. for their signature.
2. The Department will return the Construction Contract, together with the required bonds and insurance, to the Clerk of the Board for the Board Chairman's signature of the contract.
3. Upon receipt of the fully executed Construction Contract, the Department will issue a Notice to Proceed to Yubacon, Inc.
