**RE:** Authorization to Purchase Firearm

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Orion Davis has requested to purchase his department issued firearm: Glock Model 45, GEN 5, (Serial Number BKDR464). As part of that process, I was requested to inspect and determine the “blue book” value of the firearm. In my opinion, this firearm is in “excellent” condition and therefore the “blue book” value is \$460. I’ve attached the blue Book of Gun Values criteria for reference.

"Less Aggressive" Polymid Traction Rough Textured Frame (RTF) nDLC black finish, all Glock sight options available, approx. 25 oz. New late 2018.
