**Resolution for Road Closure for the 2013
“Georgetown Founder’s Day Event”**

WHEREAS, The Georgetown Rotary Club (sponsor) desires to hold the “Georgetown Founder’s Day Event” on Sunday, September 22, 2013; and

WHEREAS, said sponsors have applied for a Road Closure Permit pursuant to Vehicle Code 21102(e), Ordinance Code §12.37.010 et seq., and County Resolution 110-79 in order to promote the “Georgetown Founder’s Day Event” on Sunday, September 22, 2013;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that road closures will be in effect for Main Street and South Street in Georgetown between Highway 193 and Harkness Street. Additionally, road barricades will be located at the intersections of Main Street/Placer Street, Main Street/Orleans Street and Main Street/School Street between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 22, 2013, for the Georgetown Founder’s Day Event,” subject to the conditions set forth in Resolution No. 110-79 and subject to the conditions set forth in the “Application for Road Closure” submitted for this event.


This Resolution and the Application with conditions shall together constitute the Road Closure Permit.
