I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidelines for the temporary use of public display cases and designated areas of ~~County Facilities~~county owned facilities by individuals, organizations or institutions. This policy is not applicable to display cases with permanent exhibits, or those for ~~Department~~county department use only.

II. POLICY

The County designates specific display cases and wall areas within its facilities to provide exhibit space for the display of art or collections of public interest appealing to a wide general audience. —Designated public display cases and exhibit spaces are available to El Dorado County based community groups and organizations, ~~or the general public and county departments for the exhibition of educational items, items related to the promotion of tourism in the county, items that highlight upcoming events in the county and other items deemed appropriate by the corresponding county department to exhibit temporary displays for a designated term.~~ director.

Art exhibits must be sponsored by a recognized local arts organization or educational institution.

Displays and exhibits are intended to contribute to the enrichment and education of the community and priority is given to items that celebrate local heritage, interests and culture. The County has priority use and reserves the right to preempt any exhibit. Displays must fit within the physical space available. Items may not display a selling price. The display may include a small sign identifying the contributor.

~~i. Public Display cases in Building A are scheduled by the Board of Supervisors office. Displays are restricted to promotions of County events or Departments on a monthly basis.~~

~~ii. Public Display cases in the Libraries are scheduled by individual libraries on a monthly basis. Displayed items should draw public interest to collections, key events, local history and upcoming programs.~~
