



## RESOLUTION NO.

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

### **ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR THE EUER RANCH 1-5 ZONE OF BENEFIT #98308 AND THE EUER RANCH ZONE OF BENEFIT #98308 WITHIN COUNTY SERVICE AREA #9**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado formed County Service Area (CSA) No. 9 pursuant to Title 3, Division 2, Part 2, Chapter 2.2 of the California Government Code and established zones of benefit within CSA No. 9; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board formed the Euer Ranch 1-5 Drainage Zone of Benefit No. 98308 on April 20, 2004 by Resolution 099-2007 for the purposes of providing drainage maintenance and improvement services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board formed the Euer Ranch 6 & 7 Drainage Zone of Benefit No. 98309 on July 19, 2005 by Resolution 218-2005 for the purpose of provided drainage maintenance and improvement services, and stated at that time no advisory committee would be appointed; and

**WHEREAS**, the extended services provided within CSA No. 9 zones are authorized services pursuant to Government Code section 25213; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 10, 2024, the Board adopted the revised Policy and Procedure Guidelines for Creation and Administration of Zones of Benefit within a County Service Area (Guidelines) to establish criteria for creating, operating, and maintaining zones, including providing for the appointment, term, and purpose of Zone Advisory Committees. The Guidelines provide that an advisory committee for a zone may be appointed upon formation of the zone to serve at the pleasure of the Board; and

**WHEREAS**, the Four Seasons Owners Association within the Euer Ranch subdivision has requested the Board of Supervisors appoint an advisory committee for their two Zones of Benefit.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors that:

1. The Euer Ranch 1-5 Drainage Zone of Benefit No. 98308 and Euer Ranch 6 & 7 Drainage Zone of Benefit No. 98309 will have a single advisory committee consisting of five (5) individuals recommended by the Four Seasons Owners Association: John Hahn, Jim Benson, Dave Reardon, Bob Slater, and David Hawkins.
2. The advisory committee shall comply with the policies and procdures set forth in the Guidelines and Advisory Committee Manual.
