SUBJECT: Signage on the SPTC Corridor

The Parks and Recreation Commission requested that staff report on the cost of signs that are needed for the 2.2 miles identified on the Sacramento Placerville Transportation Corridor (SPTC) at the December 18th, 2014 meeting. The Parks and Recreation Commission also requested that staff contact the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) and ask them to review the signage plan that was developed by the ad hoc sign committee.

Staff used the signage plan developed by the ad hoc signage committee for the 2.2 mile section identified from the El Dorado Station to Greenstone Rd. The three categories of need for sign types within the 2.2 mile section are Required, Safety and Informational.

Per the request of the Parks and Recreation Commission, staff contacted the CPUC. The CPUC reviewed the signage plan and made one change; sign number 15 of the ad hoc signage plan needs to be changed to the “Standard 1-X” Private Crossing Sign per CPUC General Order NO. 75-D. The sign type also needs to be changed from Safety to Required. Staff used the Road Traffic Sign website to gather the cost of the signs.

*Rail prices are not completed. Prices for sign #14 and quantities for sign #22 are missing.

Currently there is no funding for trails and rails. Trail signage is the responsibility of the Parks Division and staff will evaluate the funding options during the FY 15/16 budget process.
