

Dear Ms. Silva,

Pursuant to the Solid Waste Services Rate Setting Policies and Procedures Manual for Unincorporated Areas, Section D, we are formally requesting a rate adjustment based on eighty-five (85) percent of the annual percentage change in the most recent actual change in the Consumer Price Index, All Urban Consumers, U.S. City Average – Garbage and Trash Collection (December 1983=100, series CUUR0000SEHG02), and specific to the Material Transfer Facility. We have attached a copy of the Division of Labor Statistic and research CPI table. As you will see, the increase in the Consumer Price index, All Urban Consumers, U.S. City Average – Garbage and Trash Collection annual average percentage change from 2013 to 2014 was 1.96%. Per the terms of the Solid Waste Services Agreement, dated October 21, 2014, we are requesting a change of 1.96% effective July 1, 2015.
