



RESOLUTION NO. 189-2013

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Health and Safety (“H&S”) Code Sections 123225 – 123255, the Maternal, Child and Adolescent Health (“MCAH”) Program was established effective fiscal year 1997-98 and mandates that the California Department of Public Health shall maintain a program of maternal and child health; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Public Health, pursuant to H&S Code Section 123255, maintains responsibility for allocating Federal funding via Title V and Title XIX to Local Health Jurisdictions (“LHJ”) to develop systems that protect and improve the health of California’s women of reproductive age, infants, children, adolescents, and their families; and

WHEREAS, the County of El Dorado Health and Human Services Agency has been designated as the Local Health Jurisdiction for the County, developing and implementing programs to improve the health of mothers, children, and adolescents in the local community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County of El Dorado Board of Supervisors authorizes and empowers the Director of the Health and Human Services Agency to execute in the name of the County of El Dorado, all necessary applications and supporting documents, as well as any acceptance documents, subject to review and approval by County Counsel, for the purposes of securing Federal MCAH funds administered by the State of California to implement and maintain the Maternal, Child and Adolescent Health Program for the period of July 1, 2013 to June 30, 2018.
