

RESOLUTION NO. 8670

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE REQUESTING \$20,000 IN FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM EL DORADO COUNTY FOR THE 2018/2019 FISCAL YEAR TO HELP OFFSET SOME OF THE OPERATIONAL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH PROVIDING A COMPREHENSIVE PROGRAM AT THE CITY AQUATICS CENTER

WHEREAS, the City and El Dorado County continue to work together for the benefit of our community; and

WHEREAS, in the past, the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors has been sympathetic to the fact that over 70% of the people who attend the City of Placerville Aquatics Center reside out-side the City limits; and

WHEREAS, the City requests \$20,000 for Fiscal Year 2018/2019 to offset some of the maintenance and operational costs associated with providing a comprehensive aquatics program during the summer months; and

WHEREAS, the City has an opportunity to request additional funding from El Dorado County for emergency repairs to the facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Placerville hereby requests \$20,000 in financial assistance from El Dorado County for the 2018/2019 Fiscal Year to help offset some of the operational costs associated with providing a comprehensive program at the City Aquatics Center.

The foregoing Resolution was introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Placerville held on September 25, 2018, by Councilmember Clerici, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Vice-Mayor Acuna. A poll vote was taken, which stood as follows:
