WHEREAS, the El Dorado Rose Pageant was started by Dottie Ingram's suggestion to the El Dorado County Fair in 1976 to recognize those senior women within the County who have volunteered their time unselfishly for our community; and,

WHEREAS, during the El Dorado County Fair an annual pageant is held where an elegant mature woman would be chosen to represent and be an ambassador for El Dorado County; and,

WHEREAS, the El Dorado Rose and her court will be seen in their historic costumes representing the bold pioneer spirit of the gold rush era of California, encompassing the years 1849-1910, at the opening of Fair, the Wagon Train and many other community functions which will involve many hours of volunteer work for the community; and,

WHEREAS, an El Dorado Rose represents the many accomplishments of today's older woman. She is a survivor, having experienced many changes in her lifetime. The backgrounds and lives of the Roses and court ladies are varied, but they all share a deep interest and commitment to their community's welfare.
