I have comments below on legistar item 26-0726, related to Planning Commission Bylaws

- Whole-heartedly agree to start time change to 9am!
- Procedures section 5(i) - Is it possible to include a delivery target for the agenda to the public? I believe that currently the agenda is published approx. 2 weeks prior to the meeting, but I am not aware of anywhere publication is documented. The public needs time to review the details of large items, which we do not get in the 72 hour window in BOS meetings. I would appreciate consideration of documenting a standard for publication.
- Procedures section 5(k) - The statement ".. may impact staff resources" is rather vague. I think everything has some impact on staff. Can there be a threshold of time/level of effort defined?
  - Also, how exactly should the Commission seek Board of Supervisors approval before proceeding? That makes it appear like the whole board has to approve. I would hope that any commissioner requesting an item had already spoken with their own district supervisor.
- Procedures section 5(l) - Similar to above, a little vague in the action "... request to Board of Supervisors".
  - If in fact the commission decides on a resolution for amendment to their bylaws, would not that already have to go to the board according to Article IX, Section 2.20.650? I suggest they can still work on a resolution, and simply add it would be effective with approval according to the County Code reference above.
