RESOLUTION NO. 084 -2017
OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

Probation Department CalPERS Retiree 180-Wait Period Waiver

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 21220 prohibits a person who has retired under a Public Employee's Retirement System (PERS) from being employed by a PERS participating employer without first being reinstated unless certain conditions are met; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Government Code Section 21224 a PERS retiree may be employed by a PERS participating employer without reinstatement from retirement if the retiree has specialized skills needed to perform work of a limited duration; and

WHEREAS, the California Public Employees' Pension Reform Act of 2013 prohibits a retired person from being employed, either through contract or directly, by a PERS employer for a period of 180 days following date of retirement unless the appointment is necessary to fill a critically needed position; and


WHEREAS, the County of El Dorado is a California Public Employees' Retirement System (CalPERS) participating employer and through its Probation Department employs Mental Health Program Coordinators to provide critically needed Mental Health Program Coordination services with in the Juvenile Detention Facilities in accordance with state mandated Title 15 regulations; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado hereby:


- 1) Certify that a critical need exists in the Probation Department to employ licensed staff who can provide Mental Health Program Coordination services with in the Juvenile Detention Facilities in accordance with state mandated Title 15 regulations; and
- 2) Approve the appointment of CalPERS retiree, Sally Williams, to the position of Mental Health Program Coordinator II Extra Help prior to completion of the 180-day waiting period following the date of her retirement to provide critically needed Mental Health Program Coordination services on a term limited basis not to exceed 960 hours in a fiscal year.
