



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

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PARKS & TRAILS PLAN PRIORITIES

A. RECREATION AND SPORTS FACILITIES

- 1. Build baseball/softball fields
- 2. Build multi-purpose fields (soccer, football and lacrosse fields)
- 3. Add lighting to existing fields for extended hours of use
- 4. Build more sports courts (e.g., tennis, pickleball, basketball)
- 5. Build more bocce ball or horseshoe pits
- 6. Build more disc golf courses
- 7. Develop a BMX/mountain bike park/pump track
- 8. Develop a mountain bike skills course
- 9. Provide additional outdoor fitness equipment
- 10. Build skate parks
- 11. Build a recreation center (including indoor pools, fitness equipment and exercise facilities, sports courts)
- 12.Install a climbing wall

B. PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS






