

PROCLAMATION

Of the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado In Recognition of the Golden Sierra High School - R.O.P. Construction Program "The Ultimate Cutting Edge"

WHEREAS, the Golden Sierra High School "Ultimate Cutting Edge" R.O.P. Construction Program provides high school students with a hands-on quality education in the construction trade; and,

WHEREAS, under the leadership of the program's instructor, Larry Highberger, the Golden Sierra High School Construction Program is known throughout the Sacramento Region's construction industry for the excellent construction trade education the program provides to its students; and,

WHEREAS, beginning in 1987, the Sacramento Regional Builders Exchange has hosted an annual Design/Build Competition as an opportunity to promote career awareness of the construction industry among the region's high schools and high school students, judging each participating high school's team on the completion of the design, plan review, safety, building inspections, and all phases of the construction of a 96-square-foot structure; and,

WHEREAS, the Golden Sierra High School Construction Program students have participated in 24 of the 25 annual Design/Build Competitions and have received top honors every year they have participated; and,

WHEREAS, due to the Golden Sierra High School Program's consistent demonstration of quality craftsmanship, safety, and construction standards, the judges hold the Golden Sierra High School teams to a higher standard; and,

WHEREAS, the Golden Sierra High School Construction Program again confirmed its standing as an exceptional construction education program by receiving the "Best in Show," "Craftsmanship," and "Team Safety" Awards at the 25th Annual Sacramento Regional Builders Exchange Design/Build Competition, held on May 4 – 5, 2011, at Cosumnes River College in Sacramento; and,

WHEREAS, the Golden Sierra High School Construction Program has secured these achievements and its recognition as a "first in the region" quality construction program under the direct guidance and continued commitment of instructor Larry Highberger.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado congratulates the Golden Sierra High School Construction Program, Mr. Larry Highberger, and each of the students who have participated in the "Ultimate Cutting Edge" Program, as each has contributed to the Program's continued success and leadership in high school construction education programs.
