SUBJECT: Retroactive Renewal of Agreement for Services – Item 26-0450, 5/19/26
Compassion Pathways Behavioral Health, LLC

This memo is to notify you that retroactive Amendment II with Compassion Pathways Behavioral Health, LLC, for the provision of licensed Social Rehabilitation Facilities (SRF), has been requested by the Health and Human Services Agency (HHS) Behavioral Health Division and is on the Board of Supervisor's Agenda for May 19, 2026 (File ID: 26-0450). HHS staff work to minimize these requests where it can be controlled, but a retroactive amendment to the contract was unavoidable in this situation and I wanted to provide you with some context.

Effective November 21, 2025, Bayoak SRF was added to Agreement for Services #8092 via Notice to Parties in accordance with ARTICLE 3. SERVICES AND ACCESS PROVISIONS, Section 1, FACILITIES AND MEDI-CAL SITE CERTIFICATION, Item C:

“Provider shall maintain at least the following Medi-Cal Site certified and appropriate facility(ies) for the provision of SMHS and SRTS for Clients referred by County who meet the minimum requirements for Medi-Cal eligibility. Any subsequent facilities added or change to the locations listed below, must be approved by the County, in advance and in writing, prior to any relocation, closure, or other change in physical location”

This retroactive amendment is necessary to update the rate schedule in Amended Exhibit B – Amended Provider Rates of Agreement #8092 so that it includes Bayoak SRF, facilitating payment for mandated mental health services that were delivered at this facility after it was officially added to the Agreement. Shortly after the contract addition, a conserved El Dorado County client was urgently placed at Bayoak SRF due to the discovery of a significant mold problem at the client's previous facility. Importantly, this retroactive amendment will not increase rates for service and does not require an increase in the maximum obligation of the Agreement.
