



RESOLUTION NO. _____

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, representatives of the County of El Dorado and representatives of the El Dorado County Criminal Attorney Association have met and conferred in good faith in regard to further cost saving issues for the period covering the current and future fiscal years; and

WHEREAS, said representatives have reached tentative agreement in regard to modification of Article 10 Leaves, Section 1 Management Leave of the current Memorandum of Understanding between the County of El Dorado and the El Dorado County Criminal Attorney Association covering the period of May 12, 2009 through June 30, 2010; and

WHEREAS, said representatives have reached tentative agreement to suspend the cash out provision of management leave until July 1, 2011 and to modify the management leave distribution from a current calendar year to a fiscal year under Article 10, Section 1; and

WHEREAS, members of the El Dorado County Criminal Attorney Association have voted during the week of October 5, 2009 and ratified the negotiated changes to the terms and conditions of employment contained within the attached Letter of Understanding to modify the Memorandum of Understanding, Article 10, Section 1 to both suspend the cash out provision of management leave and to modify the management leave distribution as attached.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors for the County of El Dorado approve and adopt and authorize the Chair to sign this Resolution to implement the attached Letter of Agreement, Article 10, Section 1 to amend the Memorandum of Understanding between the County of El Dorado and El Dorado County Criminal Attorney Association limited to Article 10, Section 1 for the period October 20, 2009 through June 30, 2011 and authorize Chair to sign Letter of Agreement. The attached Letter of Agreement Article 10 Section 1 shall be implemented as soon as feasible as determined by the County of El Dorado.

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors for the County of El Dorado directs the Human Resources Department and Payroll to implement the changes as soon as feasible as contained therein.
