CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE



East China Hill CSD

The Political Reform Act, Government Code 81000 et seq., requires state and local government agencies adopt and promulgate conflict of interest codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation, California Code of Regulations 18730, which contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code. It can be incorporated by public notice and hearings to conform to amendments to the Political Reform Act. Therefore the terms of the California Code of Regulations 18730 and any amendments to it duly adopted by the FPPC are hereby incorporated herein by this reference, constitute the conflict of interest code of the East China Hill Community Service District. This conflict of interest code supersedes all prior codes, which are hereby rescinded.

Board members, General Manager, and any consultants shall file a signed statement of economic interests with the El Dorado County Department of Elections. Statements are public record and will be made available upon request to the Department of Elections.

The disclosure categories include:

- 1. all interests in real property in the district other than personal residence.
- 2.all investments, business positions and income (including gifts, loans and travel payments) from sources that provide goods, equipment, vehicles, machinery or services of the type utilized by the CSD.

Any person listed above must disqualify themselves from any board business that affects those categories covered by the Conflict of Interest Code.

The above local Conflict of Interest Code was adopted by the East China Hill CSD board on the day of October 2010.
