Dear State Office of Historical Preservation,

At their regular meeting on October 21, 2020, the Placer County Historical Advisory Board (HAB) reviewed and discussed the California Historical Landmark (CHL) nomination of the Jeepers Jamboree on the Rubicon Trail event. The HAB voted unanimously to support this nomination.

The Jeepers Jamboree is the first, most unique, and best-known four-wheel off-highway vehicle event of its kind in California, the nation, and the world.

Traditionally, the Jeepers Jamboree (established in 1953) starts in Georgetown and ends near Lake Tahoe, traveling over El Dorado and Placer County roadways, including the Rubicon Trail. Recognizing this historic event as a CHL is a worthwhile endeavor and is fully supported by the HAB.
