NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED RATE INCREASE**

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held at 9:00 a.m. on June 3, 2008 in the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors Meeting Room, 330 Fair Lane, Placerville, California. The public hearing will consider a request to adjust solid waste collection rates for El Dorado Disposal Service, Inc. customers by adding a CPI of 3.30% rate increase and a fuel surcharge rate increase of 6.39% effective July 1, 2008. The proposed rates are for the unincorporated area of the County currently serviced by El Dorado Disposal Service, Inc. The current and proposed rates are as follows:
