SUBJECT: Update on Parks and Trails Advisory Commissions and Committees

The El Dorado County, Board of Supervisors has approved o.er tho pars, the formation of advisory commissions and/or committees in an effort to recogni and develop reas within the county that required review and recommendation from the comr . nity.

Currently the Parks Division of the Chief Administra . Office provides staff support for four committees/commission. They are identifie ${ }^{\prime} \neg \mathrm{w}$ with L reporting structure:

1. Parks and Recreation Commission - re $\mathrm{e}_{1}$ to the Board of Supervisors
2. Trails Advisory Committee rep ts to $\geqslant$ Parks and Recreation Commission
3. Sacramento-Placerville ${ }^{\top}$ anspor ${ }^{+}$, ion Co idor Oversight Committee-reports to the Trails Advisory Committee
4. River Management ${ }^{1}$ veison, ommittee - reports to the Planning Commission

Parks and Recreation. ommission ${ }^{\top} \mathrm{RC}$ )- The El Dorado County Ordinance Code, Chapter 2.33 of Title 2, established a rks and Recreation Commission for the purpose of overseeing the development and maintenc recreation opportunities within the county. The Commission consists of five (5) members $a_{1}$ pointed by the BOS, one for each supervisorial district. The term of each member is four (4) years and all members are appointed by the full board. The Parks and Recreation Commission's role is to review and provide recommendation to the BOS on policies, finance, development and maintenance of parks facilities. Meetings are held on the third Thursday of each month in the BOS meeting room.

Trails Advisory Committee (TAC) - Resolution 302-89, approved by the BOS on October 3, 1989, established the Hiking, Biking \& Equestrian Trails Committee as a permanent advisory committee to the Parks and Recreation Commission and abbreviated the Committee name to Trails Advisory Committee. This resolution was subsequently amended with Resolution 58-96 to reduce the number of members from eleven (11) to seven (7). The term of each member is four (4) years and all members are appointed by the full board. This Committee's role is to advise the Parks and Recreation Commission on ordinances or regulations regarding activities specific to the use of trails and bikeways within the county. The Committee meets the second Monday of each month in the BOS meeting room.

Sacramento-Placerville Transportation Corridor Oversight Committee (SPTC) - The BOS approved agenda item 11-0953 on August 16, 2011 to create the SPTC Oversight Committee comprised of three (3) representatives from Trails Advisory Committee, two (2) representatives from the railroad and two (2) property owners to provide an oversight role for the SPTC Corridor within the county. There were no term limits set when this Committee was formed and all members are appointed by the full board. The Committee meets the second Monday of each month in the BOS meeting room.

River Management Advisory Committee (RMAC) - When the BOS adopted an updated River Management Plan in 2001, the Plan called for the establishment of a standing committee to advise on appropriate measures for the Plan's implementation and to make recommendations on amendments to the Plan and related matters. The adoption of Resolution 065-2002, March 12, 2002, established the River Management Advisory Committee, consisting of seven (7) members. The membership was to be as follows: one (1) business representative, one (1) outf er representative, one (1) noncommercial boater representative, one (1) landowner/resident re esentative, one (1) representative from the Gold River District and two (2) public members-at-1 ge. The term of each member is four (4) years and all members are appointed by the full board The Com. tee meets the third Tuesday of each month at the Firehouse in Lotus.

Currently, staffing for these commission/committees asts of the Park Manager, Department Analyst and the River Supervisor. Since all commission/c. mittees are governed by the Brown Act, staff prepares and posts all agendas and nim ~ in L istar, downloads and posts audio transmissions to the website, prepares meeting vac ${ }^{1}$ is . members and sends electronic posting notifications for each separate comr $n$ and, committee. The time spent on this process can take up to six (6) hours per meet' $\delta$, dep iding on the length of the agenda and the number of attachments. Two of the comm. ees mf and wours and of those, one of them also meets on the same day of the month as anot. ommittee, which extends the work day for staff and requires overtime.

In February of 2013, L . Chief Ad inistrative Officer, Terri Daly held a workshop to discuss the roles and future direction $f$ the $c$ nmission, committees and the structure of the proposed Parks Division. The outcome was , eation of the Economic Development/Parks and Trail Division of the Chief Administrative Office. The discussion of the commission and committees has been on the agendas for each group many times, but no definitive role and future have come out of these meetings.

## Accomplishments:

- Parks and Recreation Commission recommended BOS approval of the rail excursion from the County line to Latrobe for a pancake breakfast fundraiser on the SPTC in August 2013.
- Parks and Recreation Commission recommended BOS approval of the Adopt a Trail Program for the El Dorado Trail on August 10, 2013, which would provide the structure for organizations/volunteers to perform maintenance activities on the trail/corridor.
- 2013 - SPTC created a list of corridor projects based on the SPTC Master Plan and assigned leads for the implementation of each project. The project listing is reviewed and updated at each meeting.
- A Joint meeting of the County Parks and Recreation Commission and the South Lake Tahoe Recreation Commission occurred in October 2013 to discuss the Parks and Trails Master Plan for South Lake Tahoe that is currently being developed. The two commissions discussed future collaboration and support for each other.


## Options:

1. Move commission/committee meetings to every other month.
2. Combine TAC and SPTC to form one committee.
3. Abolish TAC and SPTC and in the absence of these two mmittees, PRC would appoint adhoc committees that would be project specific, bs $-d$ issues at hand. This would eliminate the need to vet issues through all comm tees befor resenting to PRC.
4. TAC and SPTC would remain but only be use when PRC has issue that requires input from one of the committees.
5. Amend the Trails Advisory Resolution and by
6. Abolish SPTC as a committee gover od by the $L$ vn Act and re-establish as an ad-hoc committee.
