Dear Supervisor Knight,

The Cameron Park Community Services District is requesting permission to conduct a public fireworks display on Saturday, July 2, 2011 at Cameron Park Lake. The fireworks display will be part of the twelfth annual Summer Spectacular event. The fireworks display will be put on again this year by Pyro Spectaculars, a local (Shingle Springs) company which has conducted the fireworks display for Cameron Park annually since 2000, the 2004 Olympic Games, as well as other major events around the world. The display will be essentially the same size and scope as those of the previous ten years.

CAL FIRE and the Cameron Park Fire Department Fire Marshal have reviewed and approved the permit application to ensure that this public fireworks display conforms to the current State Fire Marshal regulations. Issues related to public safety, traffic, parking, security, and radio communications have been addressed.

We have received permission from the Cameron Park Airport District to use the roadways and taxiways inside the airpark for vehicle parking. We will be in contact with the El Dorado County Sheriff's Office and will hire deputies for patrol during the event. We have been in contact with County DOT regarding the establishment of a no parking fire lane along a half mile section of Cambridge Road and three side streets to ensure emergency vehicle access around the Cameron Park Lake area. We are in contact with the California Highway Patrol to coordinate efforts to manage traffic congestion in the general viewing area around Cameron Park Lake. We are working with adjoining fire districts to ensure that fire department emergency response personnel are staged at strategic locations both inside and outside of the fireworks venue.

Fireworks Display for Cameron Park Summer Spectacular July 2, 2011

Whereas Cameron Park Community Services District. desires to conduct a fireworks display at Cameron Park Lake as part of the 12th annual Summer Spectacular event for the benefit of the residents of Cameron Park; and,

Whereas, Section 8.08.050 of the County Ordinance Code restricts the use, possession, or discharge of fireworks to persons authorized by written order of the Board of Supervisors in full compliance with any conditions or restrictions contained in such order; and,

Whereas, The Cameron Park Fire Department has approved the fireworks display and will provide and dedicate personnel and equipment for onsite fire and emergency medical services throughout the event; and,

Whereas, The Cameron Park CSD/Fire Department will have obtained all necessary approvals from the El Dorado County Sheriff's Department, the Department of Transportation, and the California Highway Patrol for the fireworks display to assure traffic control, security and radio communications for the event will be provided by the appropriate agencies; and,

Whereas, the Fire Department, and/or the El Dorado County Sheriff's Department shall have the right to revoke the permission to hold the display at any time due to extreme fire or other specific danger, up to and including when the display is to begin; and,

Whereas, approval is contingent upon the obtainment of all permission, insurance and/or paid permits that may be needed from the County of El Dorado or other agencies;

Now therefore be it resolved, that the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors hereby grants permission to conduct the requested display on July 2, 2011 only, and provided that it complies fully with the aforementioned and any other additional requirements deemed necessary by fire control authorities.
