**Proclaiming May 10, 2007
"Farm Day"
in El Dorado County**

WHEREAS, agricultural production is extremely important to the El Dorado County economy generating \$42.9 million in direct crop sales in 2005, resulting in an estimated \$434 million overall positive impact to the community and,

WHEREAS, California's diverse agriculture deserves special recognition for its incredible achievements in providing the products necessary for feeding, clothing, and sheltering the citizens of our country and the world; and,

WHEREAS, maintaining a healthy, secure agricultural industry requires that all consumers understand and appreciate agriculture's significant role in their lives and well-being; and,

WHEREAS, farmers and ranchers are good stewards of the land they rely upon; and,

WHEREAS, agricultural literacy instruction provides the consumer an understanding of their relationship to the agricultural products they use.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED, the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors does hereby proclaim May 10, 2007, as "Farm Day" in El Dorado County, in recognition of the importance of educating our community about how commodities for food, fiber, and shelter are produced and where they come from.
