

PROPOSED AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SHERIFFS OF EL DORADO COUNTY
AND ALPINE COUNTY, FOR THE HOUSING OF INMATES.

The purpose of this agreement between the Sheriff of El Dorado County and the Sheriff of Alpine County, is for the transfer of State funds (approximately \$150,000.), which was to be received by Alpine County in connection with State Proposition 52 and 86. Alpine County has requested that with exception of approximately \$6,000., funds from State Propositions 52 and 86 that the remaining balance of approximately \$150,000. be transferred to El Dorado County to assist in the construction of jail bed space in El Dorado County. In return, El Dorado County Sheriff's Department will make available a maximum of three jail beds per day to house Alpine County's inmates.

This agreement to remain in affect until revoked by either party. Either county may cancel this agreement without cause or retribution. Written notice for revocation shall be submitted by the revoking county ninety days in advance.

Sheriff Larry Kuhl is authorized to sign documents on behalf of Alpine County between the Board of Corrections and Alpine County on matters concerning Proposition 52 and 86.


