Mr John Hidahl,

My name is Lance Kramer. I moved to El Dorado County in 1963. In 1980 I left to pursue a career as a brakeman/conductor with the Santa Fe Railroad. Ultimately, I left the railroad and did a career with the California Department of Corrections. In 2008 I moved back to El Dorado County and it has been wonderful being back home again.

Approximately one year ago AT&T approached me along with two other neighbors about our interest in having a cell tower placed on our property. All three of us expressed an interest in a cell tower on our property but because my location was the highest in elevation AT&T selected mine.

Soon after AT&T selected my site, one neighbor along with another neighbor, who originally wanted the tower, became opposed to a cell tower on my property. Last year and more recently this past month I have had the opportunity to speak with all 10 home owners who live on Victory Mine road. The majority of everyone on our road wants the tower and are excited about better cell coverage and high speed internet.

On January 11th the planning commissioners voted for approval of the tower. I have recently been informed that the commissioners decision has been appealed by my neighbor to the county board of supervisors.

The proposed site for the tower is non-intrusive to any of my neighbors views and is a perfect site to give high-speed Internet and better cell coverage to areas otherwise have little to no cell coverage.

The proposed cell site overlooks west over all of the Oak Hill road area and Diamond Springs.

South, the site overlooks all of the Sand Ridge road area and Mount Aukum.
