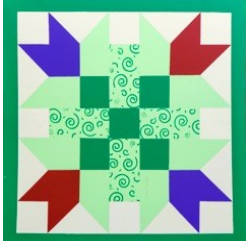


WHAT IS THE QUILT TRAIL PROJECT?

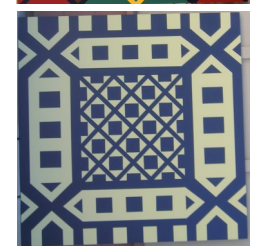
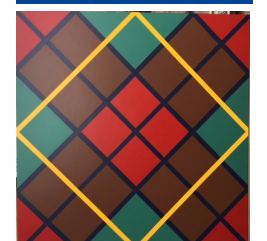
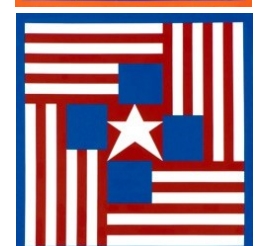
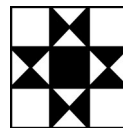

These Quilt Trail blocks are painted on wood and vary in size and considered works of art that adorn old barns, historic buildings, grace a garden or gang on rustic posts on our Farm Trails Member’s property. Most designs have historic meaning and background—members choose a design that has family ties or represent their history.



There are over 5,000 quilt trails in the US and Canada. El Dorado County is proud to display 21 different and unique Quilt Blocks on the trail today—keep checking, there are two more being painted.
