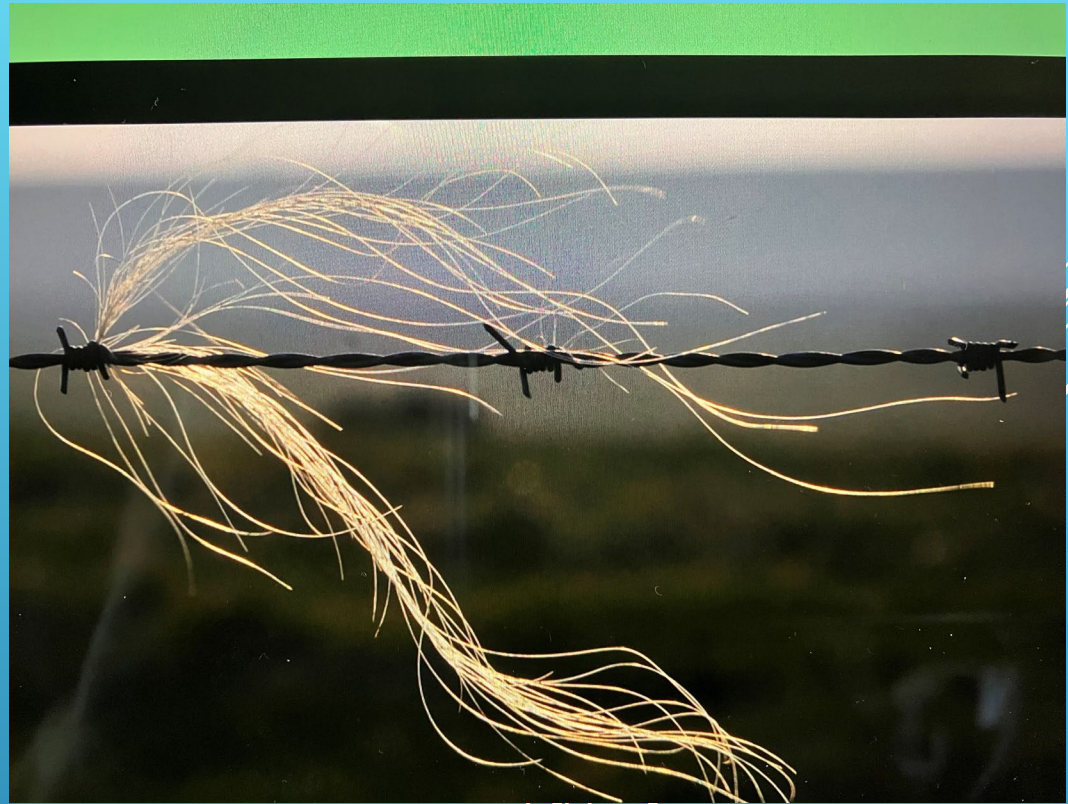

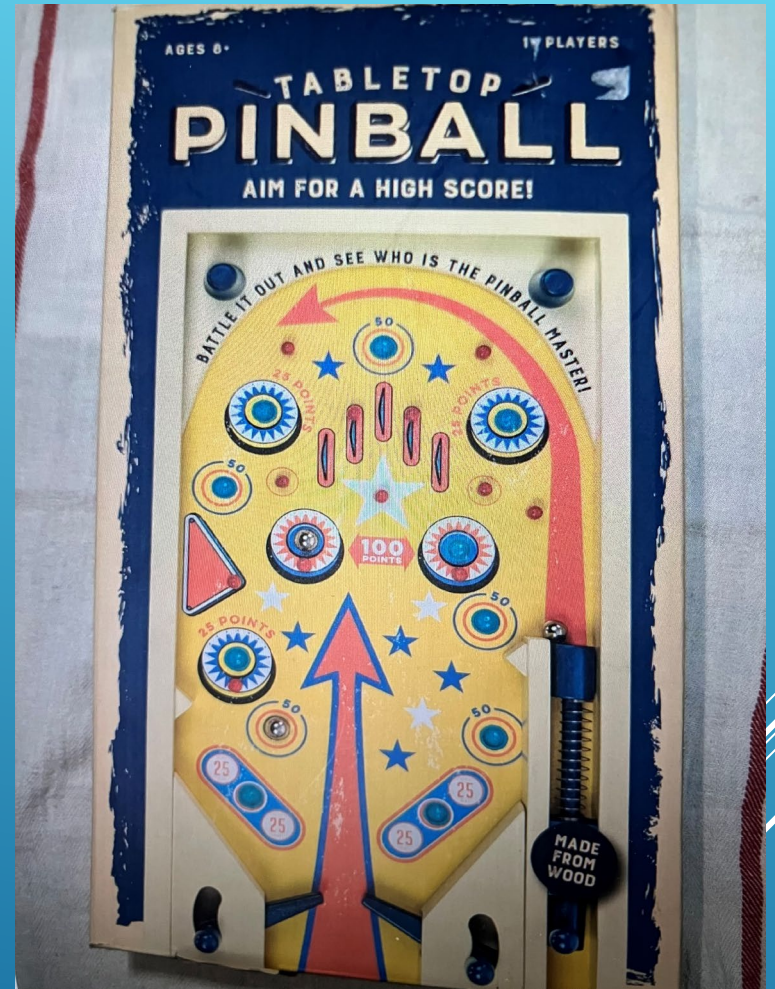
THE PROBLEM...

- starvation



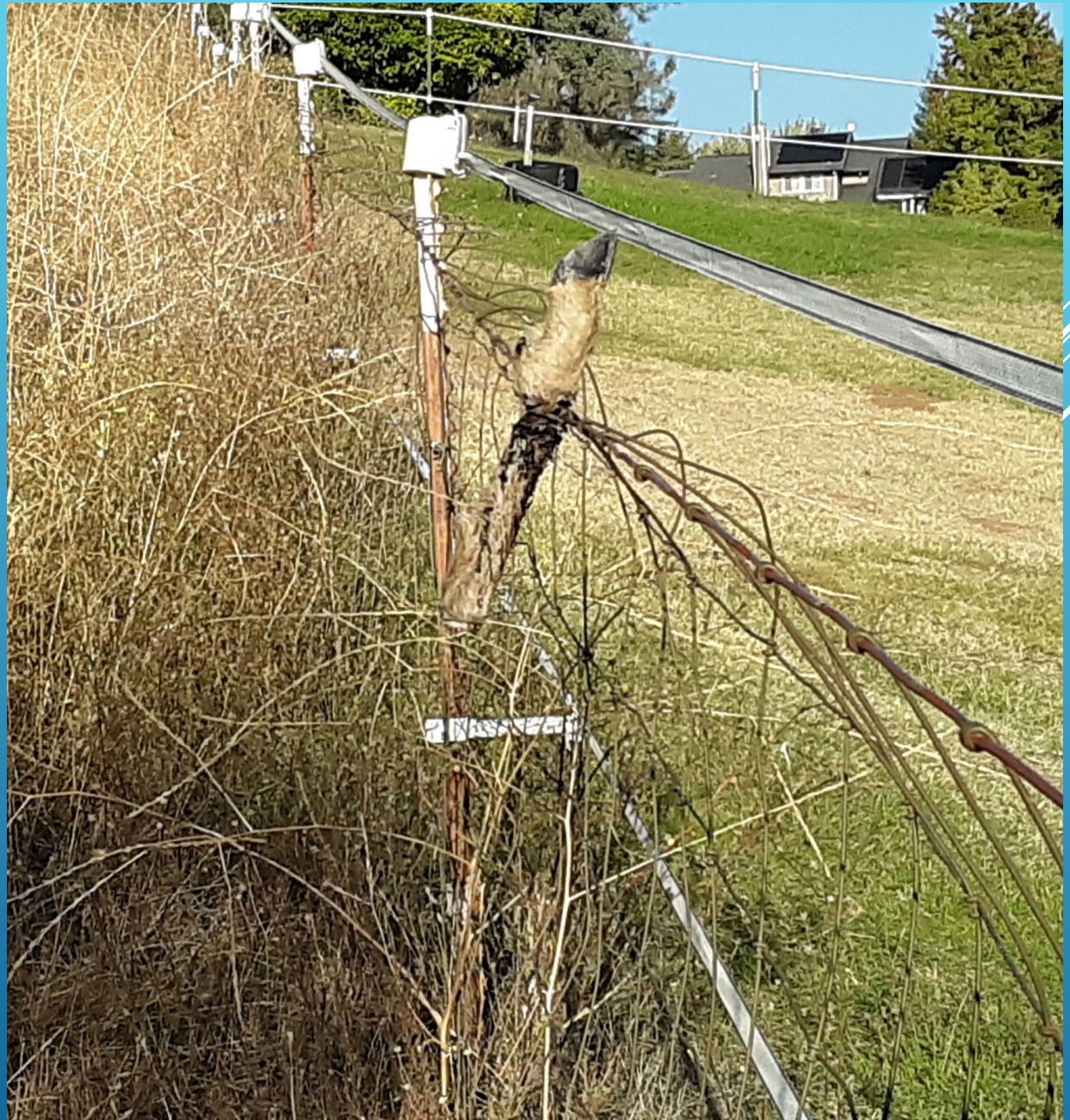

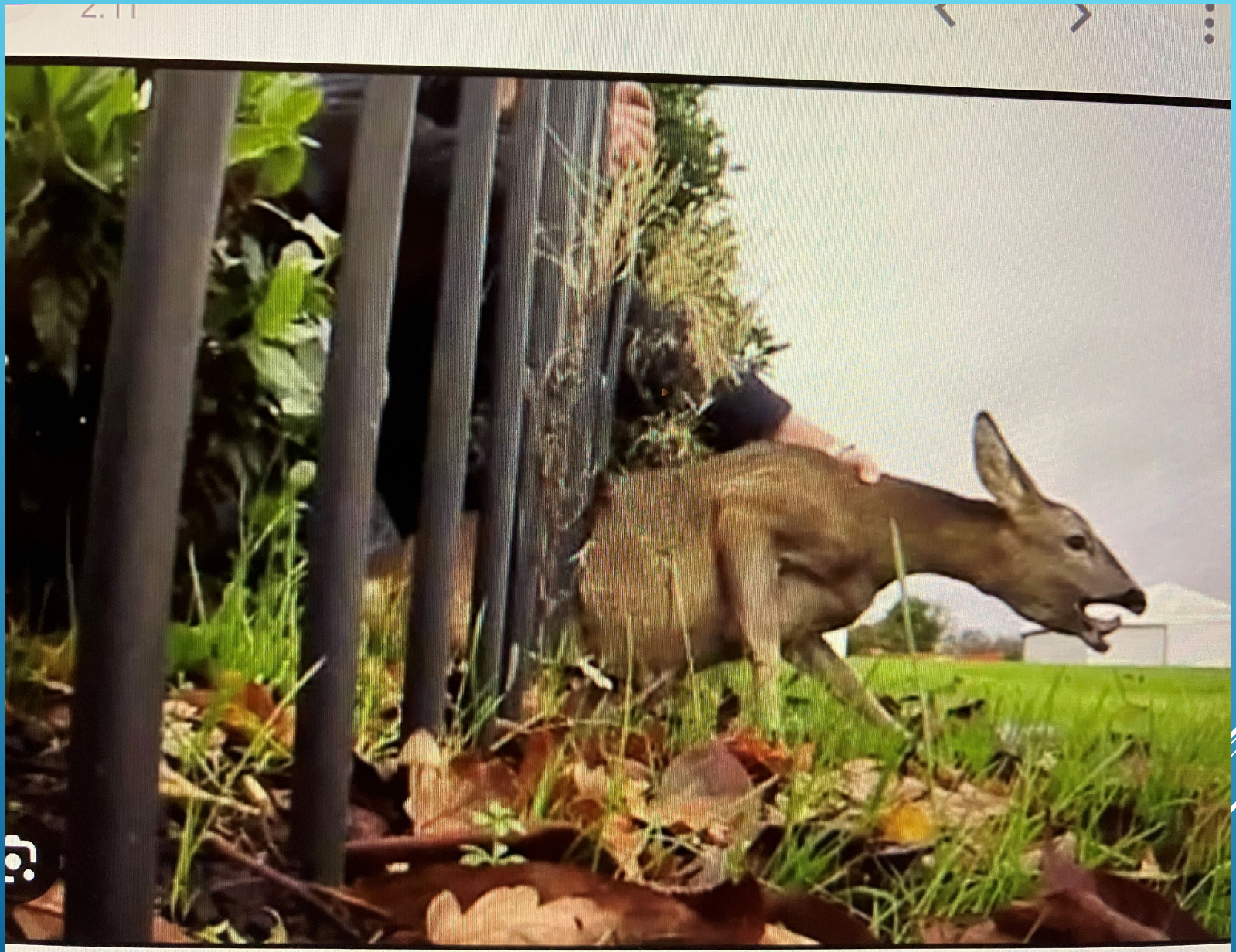


RESIDENTIAL FENCE TYPES

NEW FENCE DESIGN TIPS

Consider...

- **wildlife-friendly fencing**
 - **a 'living fence' for privacy**
Use plants or trees as fences
 - **fencing smaller 'zones'**
Leave areas for wildlife passage
 - **eliminate extra 'top wire' strands**
 - **or... No fencing at all !**

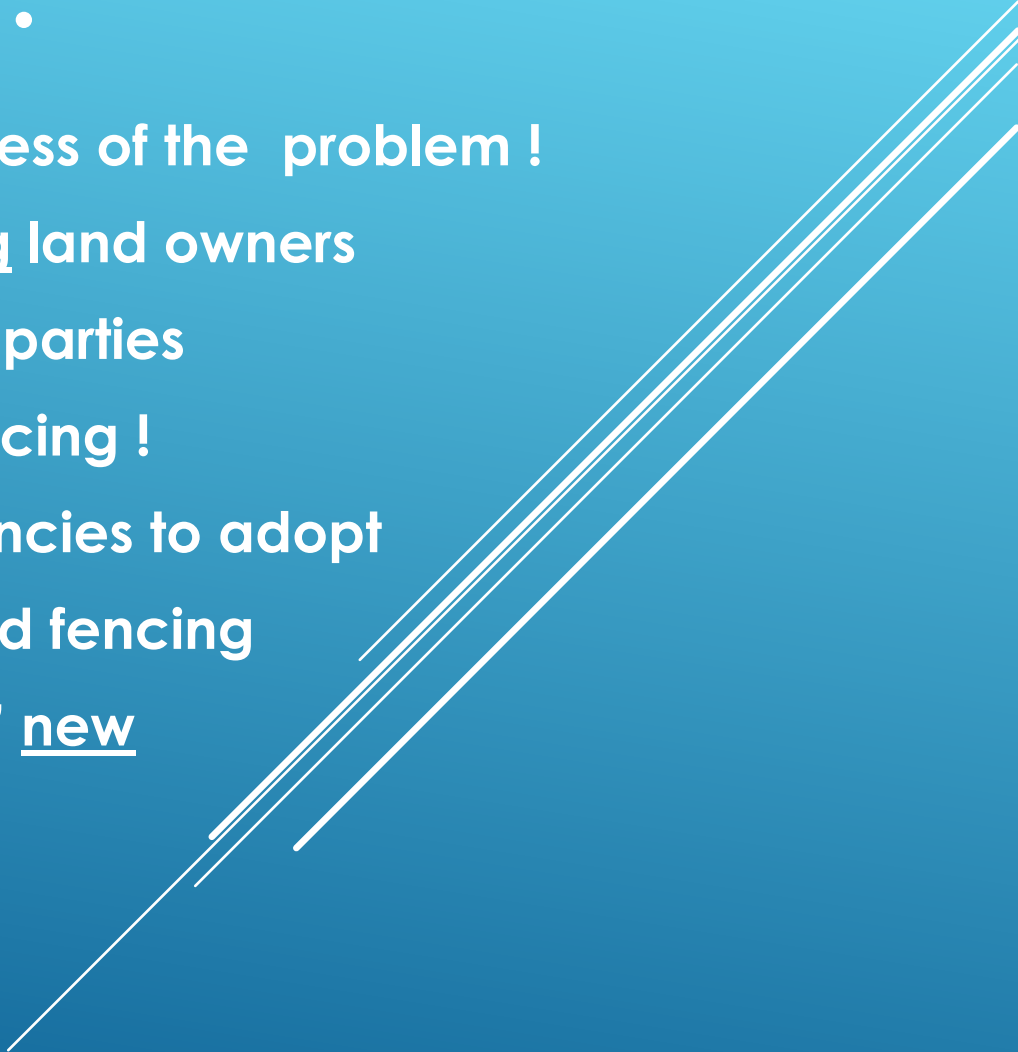

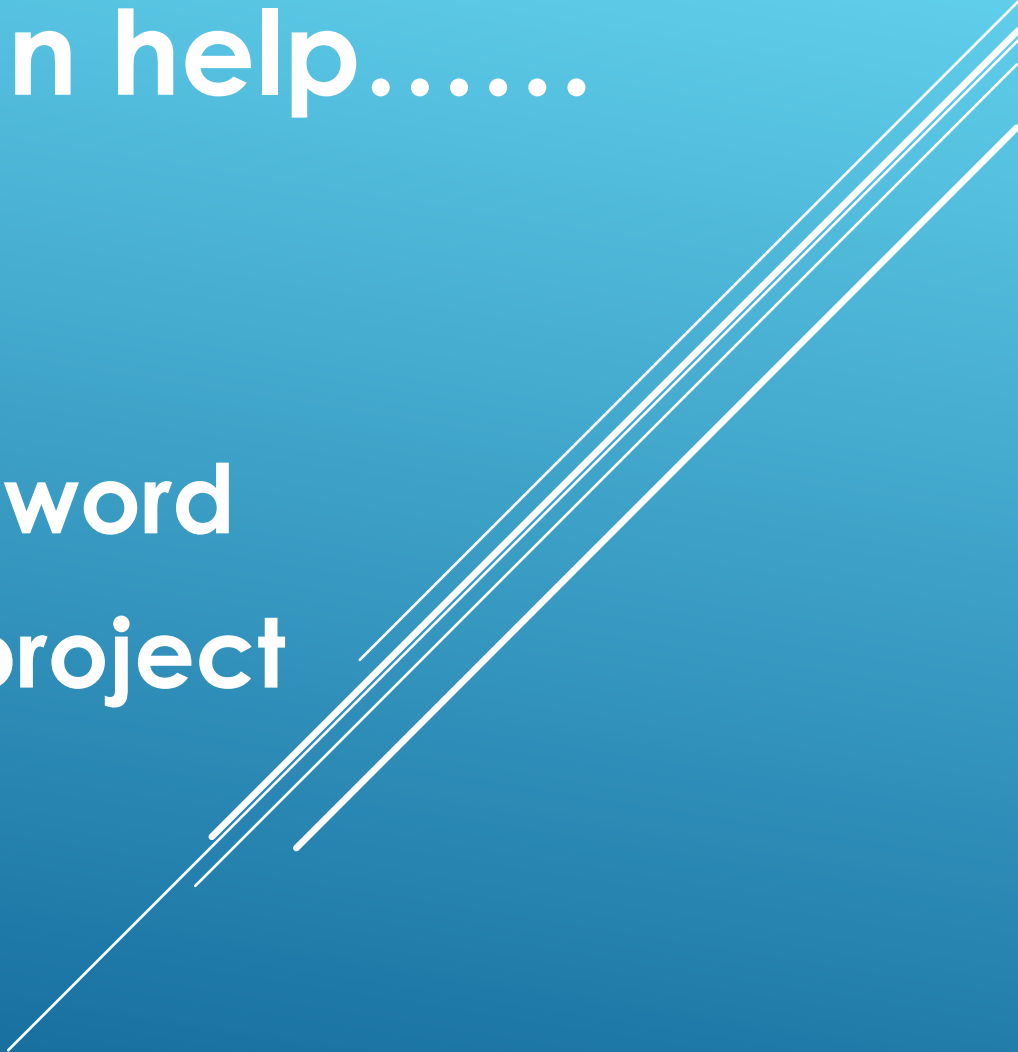
