We are requesting that El Dorado County continue to support the Capital Southeast Connector JPA's proposal to build a paved bike path from Stonebriar Drive in El Dorado Hills west to Empire Ranch Rd. in Folsom. The proposed bike path will provide an important route for cyclists in the southern part of El Dorado Hills to access the extensive bike paths in Folsom. Those bike paths connect to the American River Bike Trail, and allow access to the unpaved section of the El Dorado Trail which runs from White Rock Road to the town of El Dorado, connecting to the paved bike path there.

Currently, the only way for El Dorado hills residents to access those trails without transporting their bikes on vehicles is to ride down White Rock Rd., which is very dangerous for cyclists because it is narrow and has no shoulders, as well as blind spots and heavy high speed traffic.

Your continued support for integrated network of bicycle and pedestrian routes in the region will be greatly appreciated.
