ORDINANCE NO. 4812

**THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO DOES
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Section 17.38.062, of Chapter 17.38 of Title 17 of the El Dorado County Ordinance Code, entitled Avigation and Noise Easement Required, is hereby removed in its entirety.

Section 2. Section 17.38.062 of Chapter 17.38 of Title 17 of the El Dorado County Ordinance Code is hereby added as follows:

17.38.062 Airport Land Use Commission Review.

No discretionary permit of any type shall be approved for development or activity subject to the airport safety (AA) regulations until the county has forwarded the application to the agency responsible for the administration of the CLUP for review as to consistency with the plan and the county has received any recommended conditions or restrictions in order to ensure the public health, safety and general welfare, including but not limited to the requirement for an appropriate avigation and/or noise easement.

Section 3. Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the suspension of Ordinance Code section 17.38.062 of Chapter 17.38 of Title 17 of the El Dorado County Ordinance Code enacted on August 5, 2008 by adoption of Ordinance number 4784 shall be lifted and of no further force and effect.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days following adoption
