I have concerns regarding some provisions of the defensible space ordinance while will take effect June 2020.

As it reads now, there are NO consequences for non-compliance suggest you propose consequences specifically for owners who are non cooperative and/or absentee owners.

As it reads now, there are NO provisions for inspectors; suggest you propose funding and hiring effective the same day the ordinance if effective.

As it reads now, NO incentives for compliance exist; suggest you propose the BOS approve a county DR (Disaster Recovery ordinance); with a DR in place, the expense to establish and maintain the prescribed area will be tax deductible.
