SUBJECT: Advanced Placement for Geologist

Honorable Board Members:

#### □ Recommendations:

That your Board authorize the advanced step placement for the Geologist position, effective immediately, to support the Environmental Management department as well as other County departments as deemed appropriate, and air quality management programs.

#### ☐ Reasons for Recommendations:

The Environmental Management Department has been recruiting for the Geologist position for approximately one year. The first recruitment yielded only 2 candidates and the chosen candidate did not accept the job offer due to salary related issues. Following the failed recruitment, the Department requested that Human Resources re-evaluate the salary for this position. Human Resources re-evaluated the salary and the Board approved an increase in salary on May 9, 2006, Resolution 129-2006. The Board also approved a relocation expense for this position. The second recruitment produced only four (4) potential candidates for the Geologist position.

Our top candidate for this position, Robert Lauritzen, has conditionally accepted the position to be hired at Step 4 of the salary schedule. The candidate for the Geologist position has an extensive background in environmental compliance, underground storage tanks, lead and asbestos surveys, and groundwater and contaminant transport modeling. The County currently has approximately 50 contaminated sites and the expertise of this candidate would be of great benefit to the County with respect to site characterization and remediation activities. The candidate also has substantial experience with managing, leading and implementing projects for both the private and public sector workplaces. The experience and knowledge possessed by this candidate should prove to be invaluable to this position, as he will be the first to hold such a position for the County. El Dorado County requires certification from the State of California for this position, which the candidate has. To compete with the current salary of the candidate, and because of the extensive knowledge and background that the candidate would bring to this position, and because of the difficulty of trying to fill this position with a qualified individual for the past year, we are recommending that the candidate be hired at Step 4 of the current salary schedule.

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Per the requirements of the Relocation Reimbursement policy (Policy E-6) the candidate for this position will not be eligible to receive reimbursement for any relocation expenses. The funding for this position will come from Permit fees and charges for services in the Environmental Health division.
