

## RESOLUTION NO. 101-2016

## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

## Resolution for Road Closure for the "Wilson Estates Sewer Line"

WHEREAS, Renasci Homes (Sponsor) desires to close a portion of Uplands Drive and Malcom Dixon Road starting Wednesday, June 29, 2016, for thirty (30) calendar days or until the work is complete, whichever is sooner; and

WHEREAS, said Sponsor has requested a road closure "Special Event Permit" pursuant to Vehicle Code 21101(e), Ordinance Code §12.37.010 et seq., and County Resolution 110-79 in order to construct the "Wilson Estates Sewer Line" on Wednesday, June 29, 2016, for thirty (30) calendar days; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a road closure will be in effect for two roads in the El Dorado Hills area during construction of a sewer line to serve the Wilson Estates development. The two roads are Uplands Drive and Malcom Dixon Road. The daily closures will begin on June 29, 2016, and continue for thirty (30) calendar days or until the work is complete, whichever is sooner, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. The closure is subject to conditions set forth in Resolution No. 110-79 dated May 1, 1979.

This Resolution and the "Special Event Permit Application" with fulfilled conditions shall together constitute the road closure "Special Event Permit."
