



RESOLUTION NO. xxx-2025
OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, on November 4, 2024, the Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance No. 5211, adding Chapter 8.68 to Title 8 of the El Dorado County Ordinance Code, to regulate tobacco retailers and establish a tobacco retail license, with an effective enforcement date of April 1, 2025;

WHEREAS, on October 22, 2024, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 178-2024 establishing Tobacco Retailers License Fees to be enable cost recovery of the costs associated with processing annual licenses for the Tobacco Retailer License as required under Ordinance No. 5211;

WHEREAS, on March 25, 2025, the Board of Supervisors provided conceptual approval to amend Ordinance No. 5211, directed staff to return to the Board and present recommendations for modifications to Ordinance 5211, and deferred enforcement in the interim;

WHEREAS, on October 21, 2025 the Board of Supervisors introduced an ordinance to repeal the Tobacco Retail License Ordinance, Ordinance No. 5211; and

WHEREAS, the Tobacco Retailers License Fees are no longer needed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the county of El Dorado that the Board of Supervisors does hereby repeal in its entirety Resolution No. 178-2024, entitled “Resolution Establishing Tobacco Retailers License Fee Structure.”
